1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 327F.15 REFLECTIVE DEVICES ON
2 RAILROAD CARS -- PENALTY.

3 1. Any person, firm, or corporation owning or operating a
4 railroad car in this state shall ensure that the railroad car,
5 while operated upon stationary rails in this state and while
6 coupled with a railroad train, shall be equipped with a
7 reflective device plainly visible to approaching vehicular
8 traffic pursuant to rules established by the state department
9 of transportation.

10 2. A violation of this section shall, upon conviction, be
11 subject to a schedule "one" penalty.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill requires that all railroad cars while operating
14 on the railroad tracks of this state shall be equipped with a
15 reflective device plainly visible to approaching vehicles
16 pursuant to rules established by the state department of
17 transportation. A violation of this section is considered a
18 schedule "one" violation pursuant to section 327C.5,
19 subjecting the violator to a \$100 fine for each violation.
