

1 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 104
2 BY WARNSTADT, WHITEAD, KLEMME, RANTS,
3 BUKTA, and SCHERRMAN

4 A Concurrent Resolution providing for the establishment
5 of a committee by the Legislative Council to conduct
6 a study of economic development issues related to the
7 distribution of goods.

8 WHEREAS, the distribution of goods and the
9 development of distribution centers for goods in the
10 state is considered an important segment of the
11 economy of the State of Iowa; and

12 WHEREAS, the General Assembly believes a
13 comprehensive study of the distribution of goods and
14 the development of distribution centers in the state
15 is necessary and in the best interests of the economic
16 health of the citizens of the State of Iowa; NOW
17 THEREFORE,

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE
19 SENATE CONCURRING, That the Legislative Council is
20 requested to appoint an interim study committee to
21 conduct a comprehensive study of the distribution of
22 goods and the development of distribution centers in
23 the state by studying all statutory, regulatory,
24 taxation, and other issues related to the distribution
25 of goods and the development of distribution centers;
26 and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the interim study
28 committee should be composed of 10 members consisting
29 of members from both political parties and both houses
30 of the Iowa General Assembly; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee should
2 be staffed by the Legislative Service Bureau and the
3 Legislative Fiscal Bureau. The committee should begin
4 its deliberations following the adjournment of the
5 1998 Session of the General Assembly and should issue
6 its report of recommendations by January 1, 1999.
