HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 114

BY FALLON

1 A Concurrent Resolution requesting approval of  
2 legislation closing the School of Americas.

3 WHEREAS, the School of Americas, located in Fort  
4 Beaming, Georgia, trains Latin American soldiers to  
5 make war on their own people; and

6 WHEREAS, manuals used at the School of Americas  
7 have recommended arrest, imprisonment, hypnotism,  
8 torture, and execution as acceptable means of  
9 coercion; and

10 WHEREAS, operating expenses for the School of  
11 Americas are estimated to be \$18,400,000 each year;  
12 and

13 WHEREAS, operation and support of the School of  
14 Americas continues to stand as a barrier to  
15 establishing a new and constructive relationship  
16 between the United States of America and Latin  
17 American countries; and

18 WHEREAS, legislation has been proposed in the  
19 United States Congress to close the School of  
20 Americas; NOW THEREFORE,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE  
22 SENATE CONCURRING, That the United States Senate pass  
23 S. 980 relating to the closing of the School of  
24 Americas; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the United State House  
26 of Representatives pass H.R. 611 relating to the  
27 closing of the School of Americas; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this

1 Resolution be sent by the Chief Clerk of the House of  
2 Representatives to the President of the United States  
3 Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of  
4 Representatives, and the members of Iowa's  
5 congressional delegation.
