## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the disclosure of certain information relating
2 to tobacco products and cigarettes sold in the state and
3 providing a penalty.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
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- Section 1. NEW SECTION. 453A.57 DISCLOSURE OF
- 2 INFORMATION -- TOBACCO PRODUCTS AND CIGARETTES.
- Any manufacturer of tobacco products or cigarettes sold
- 4 in this state shall submit to the Iowa department of public
- 5 health for the prior calendar year, in a form specified by the
- 6 Iowa department of public health a report annually, on or
- 7 before January 15 which lists for each brand and product sold
- 8 during the prior calendar year, all of the following
- 9 information:
- 10 a. The identity of any added constituent, other than
- 11 tobacco, water, or reconstituted tobacco sheet made wholly
- 12 from tobacco, to be listed in descending order according to
- 13 weight, measure, or numerical count.
- 14 b. The nicotine yield ratings, which shall accurately
- 15 predict nicotine intake for an average consumer, based upon
- 16 standards to be established by the Iowa department of public
- 17 health.
- 18 2. The nicotine yield ratings provided, and any other
- 19 information in the annual reports with respect to which the
- 20 Iowa department of public health determines that there is a
- 21 reasonable scientific basis for concluding that the
- 22 availability of the information could reduce risks to public
- 23 health, shall be public records subject to examination and
- 24 copying under chapter 22, provided that before the information
- 25 is publicly disclosed the Iowa department of public health
- 26 shall request the advice of the attorney general as to whether
- 27 the disclosure would constitute an unconstitutional taking of
- 28 property, and shall not disclose the information unless and
- 29 until the attorney general advises that the disclosure would
- 30 not constitute an unconstitutional taking.
- 31 3. A manufacturer shall not be required to identify or
- 32 disclose the specific amount of any ingredient that has been
- 33 approved as safe when burned and inhaled by the United States
- 34 food and drug administration, the United States public health
- 35 service, or the United States department of health and human

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1 services, or that has been designated by the United States

2 food and drug administration as generally recognized as safe

3 when burned and inhaled.

4 4. A manufacturer who violates this section is subject to

5 denial of issuance of a permit or revocation of a permit

6 issued under this chapter and is guilty of a serious

7 misdemeanor.

8 EXPLANATION

9 This bill requires a manufacturer of tobacco products or

10 cigarettes doing business in this state to submit an annual

11 report to the Iowa department of public health which provides

12 information including the identity of any added constituent

13 and the nicotine yield rating of the product. The information

14 submitted is only to be made a public record if the attorney

15 general determines that disclosing the information is not an

16 unconstitutional taking of property. The bill does not

17 require that a manufacturer disclose the specific amount of

18 any ingredient that has been approved by a federal agency as

19 safe when burned and inhaled or which is generally recognized

20 as safe when burned and inhaled by the United States food and

21 drug administration. A manufacturer who violates the

22 requirements of the bill is subject to denial or revocation of

23 a permit and is guilty of a serious misdemeanor.

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
