This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, Sec. 2. 5 6 takes effect upon enactment and applies retroactively to 7 January 1, 1997, for tax years beginning on or after that 8 date. EXPLANATION 9 The bill provides that an activity of a foreign corporation 10 ll which involves participation in job training or education for 12 its employees does not constitute doing business within the 13 state or deriving income from sources within the state for the 14 purposes of the imposition of the state corporate income tax. 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## HOUSE FILE 117 FISCAL NOTE

A fiscal note for House File 117 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

House File 117 provides that an activity of a foreign corporation which involves participation in job training or education for its employees does not constitute nexus for the purposes of the imposition of the State corporate income tax. Nexus is a condition in which a business is determined to be doing business within the State of Iowa.

## FISCAL IMPACT

House File 117 is expected to have an annual impact of less than \$100,000. It is possible that some future nexus audit may hinge exclusively on the employee training issue.
