NEW SECTION. 80.19A ROAD CONDITIONS REPORTING 1 Section 1. 2 SERVICE. The commissioner of public safety shall provide information 4 to the public regarding weather-related conditions on the 5 public highways of the state. The service shall be provided 6 through toll-free telephone access and may be provided by 7 computer access. Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated from the 9 general fund of the state to the department of public safety 10 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 11 30, 1998, \$88,000, or so much thereof as is necessary, of 12 which, up to \$25,000 shall be used for the establishment, and 13 up to \$63,000 shall be used for the operation, of a weather-14 related public highway condition reporting service. 15 EXPLANATION 16 This bill provides for the establishment of a service in 17 the department of public safety which will provide information 18 to the public regarding weather-related public highway 19 condition reports through a toll-free telephone number or 20 through computer access.
