1 Section 1. Section 481A.48, Code 1997, is amended by
2 adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

3 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. The commission shall establish
4 pistol or revolver seasons for hunting deer to coincide with
5 one or more firearm seasons. Any pistol or revolver firing a
6 three hundred fifty-seven thousandths of one inch caliber or
7 larger, centerfire, straight wall ammunition propelling an
8 expanding-type bullet is legal for hunting deer during the
9 pistol or revolver seasons. The possession of a revolver or
10 pistol which does not fire centerfire, straight wall
11 ammunition propelling an expanding-type bullet or a self-
12 loading pistol or revolver having a capacity of more than
13 eleven cartridges in its magazine and chamber combined is
14 prohibited while hunting deer. A person possessing a
15 prohibited pistol or revolver while hunting deer commits a
16 scheduled violation under section 805.8, subsection 5,
17 paragraph "h".

18 Sec. 2. Section 805.8, subsection 5, paragraph h, Code
19 1997, is amended by adding the following new subparagraph:

20 NEW SUBPARAGRAPH. (5) Possession of a prohibited pistol
21 or revolver while hunting deer, the scheduled fine is one
22 hundred dollars.

23 EXPLANATION

24 The bill directs the natural resource commission to
25 establish pistol or revolver seasons for deer hunting. The
26 seasons are to coincide with one or more firearm seasons. The
27 pistols or revolvers must fire a .357 of an inch caliber or
28 larger, centerfire, straight wall ammunition propelling an
29 expanding-type bullet. The possession of a self-loading
30 pistol or revolver having a capacity of more than 11
31 cartridges in its magazine and chamber combined is prohibited
32 while hunting deer.

33 A scheduled fine of \$100 is provided for hunters using
34 prohibited types of pistols or revolvers.

NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. The commission shall establish
one or more pistol or revolver seasons for hunting deer as
separate firearm seasons or to coincide with one or more other
firearm deer hunting seasons. Any pistol or revolver firing a
magnum three hundred fifty-seven thousandths of one inch
caliber or larger, centerfire, straight wall ammunition
propelling an expanding-type bullet is legal for hunting deer
during the pistol or revolver seasons. The commission shall
adopt rules to allow black powder pistols or revolvers for
hunting deer. The rules shall not allow pistols or revolvers
with shoulder stock or long-barrel modifications. The barrel
length of a pistol or revolver use for deer hunting shall be
at least four inches. The rules may limit types of
ammunition. A person who is sixteen years of age or less
shall not hunt deer with a pistol or revolver. A person
possessing a prohibited pistol or revolver while hunting deer
commits a scheduled violation under section 805.8, subsection
5, paragraph "h".

Sec. 2. Section 805.8, subsection 5, paragraph h, Code
1997, is amended by adding the following new subparagraph:

NEW SUBPARAGRAPH. (5) Possession of a prohibited pistol
