

1 Section 1. Section 147.13, subsection 8, Code 1997, is
2 amended to read as follows:

8. For dentistry and-dental-hygiene, dental examiners.
Sec. 2. Section 147.13, Code 1997, is amended by adding
5 the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 19. For dental hygienists, dental hygiene
7 examiners.

8 Sec. 3. Section 147.14, Code 1997, is amended by adding9 the following new subsection:

10 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 17. For dental hygiene examiners, four 11 members licensed to practice dental hygiene, one member 12 licensed to practice dentistry who has supervised or worked in 13 collaboration with a dental hygienist for at least four out of 14 the immediately preceding five years, and two members not 15 licensed to practice dentistry or dental hygiene who shall 16 represent the general public. A majority of the members of 17 the board constitutes a quorum.

18 Sec. 4. Section 147.74, Code 1997, is amended by adding 19 the following new subsection:

20 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 19A. A dental hygienist licensed under 21 chapter 153 may use the words "licensed dental hygienist" 22 after the person's name or signify the same by the use of the 23 letters "L.D.H." after the person's name.

24 Sec. 5. Section 147.80, subsection 11, Code 1997, is 25 amended to read as follows:

26 11. License to practice dental hygiene issued upon the 27 basis of an examination given by the board of dental <u>hygiene</u> 28 examiners, license to practice dental hygiene issued under a 29 reciprocal agreement, renewal of a license to practice dental 30 hygiene.

31 Sec. 6. Section 153.15, Code 1997, is amended to read as 32 follows:

33 153.15 DENTAL HYGIENISTS -- SCOPE OF TERM.

34 A licensed dental hygienist may perform those services35 which are educational, therapeutic, and preventive in nature

1 which attain or maintain optimal oral health as determined by 2 the board of dentistry dental hygienists and may include but 3 are not necessarily limited to complete oral prophylaxis, 4 application of preventive agents to oral structures, exposure 5 and processing of radiographs, administration of medicaments 6 prescribed by a licensed dentist, obtaining and preparing 7 nonsurgical, clinical and oral diagnostic tests for 8 interpretation by the dentist, preparation of preliminary 9 written records of oral conditions for interpretation by the 10 dentist. Such services shall be performed under supervision 11 of a licensed dentist and in a dental office, a public or 12 private school, public health agencies, hospitals, and the 13 armed forces, but nothing herein shall be construed to 14 authorize a dental hygienist to practice dentistry.

15 Sec. 7. Section 153.15A, subsection 1, unnumbered 16 paragraph 1, Code 1997, is amended to read as follows:

In addition to requirements adopted by rule by the board of dental hygienists, in order to obtain a license as a dental hygienist, an applicant shall present evidence to the board of both of the following:

21 Sec. 8. Section 153.23, Code 1997, is amended to read as 22 follows:

153.23 NOTICE OF INTENTION NOT TO RENEW LICENSE.
If, prior to the renewal of any license to practice
dentistry or dental hygiene, the board <u>of dental examiners or</u>
the board of dental hygiene examiners, respectively, is
informed upon oath or affirmation lawfully administered, that
any such applicant has during the term of the applicant's last
license or the last renewal thereof violated any of the
provisions of this chapter or chapter 147 or committed any of
the acts of unprofessional conduct as defined in this chapter,
or if any member of the board certifies in writing that the
member is credibly informed that such violation of law or act
of unprofessional conduct has been so committed by such

In such event the renewal of such the license shall 8 not be made prior to the date so fixed and the making of such 9 a showing by the applicant.

10 Sec. 9. Section 153.24, Code 1997, is amended to read as 11 follows:

12 153.24 TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING.

13 The time and place of such hearing before the board of 14 dental examiners or the board of dental hygiene examiners 15 shall be open to public inspection at all reasonable hours. 16 Sec. 10. Section 153.25, Code 1997, is amended to read as 17 follows:

18 153.25 HEARING CONFIDENTIAL.

19 At such hearing, which shall be confidential unless the 20 applicant requests it be a public one, any person having 21 knowledge of the facts pertaining to the propriety of the 22 renewal of such license may testify thereto, and the 23 chairperson of the board <u>of dental examiners or the board of</u> 24 <u>dental hygiene examiners</u> is hereby empowered to and shall 25 administer oaths to all such persons offering testimony. 26 Sec. 11. Section 153.26, Code 1997, is amended to read as 27 follows:

28 153.26 REJECTION OF RENEWAL.

If at said the hearing, or upon appeal if taken as hereinafter provided, it shall be established that the applicant has theretofore failed to comply with all of the provisions of this chapter or has during the term of the license or the last renewal thereof committed any of the acts d of unprofessional conduct as defined in this chapter, then the board of dental examiners or the board of dental hygiene

3 Sec. 12. Section 153.27, Code 1997, is amended to read as 4 follows:

5 153.27 MINUTES OF EVIDENCE.

6 The minutes of all evidence heard by the said board of 7 dental examiners or the board of dental hygiene examiners or 8 exhibits introduced at said the hearing for or against the 9 granting of said the application for license, together with 10 the order of the board granting or rejecting such application 11 for renewal of license, which shall be in writing, shall be 12 and become a part of the records of said the board and shall 13 be open to public inspection at all reasonable hours. Written 14 notice of said the order shall forthwith be mailed to the 15 applicant by the board.

16 Sec. 13. Section 153.28, Code 1997, is amended to read as
17 follows:

18 153.28 JUDICIAL REVIEW.

19 Judicial review of actions of the board <u>of dental examiners</u> 20 <u>or the board of dental hygiene examiners</u> may be sought in 21 accordance with the terms of the Iowa administrative procedure 22 Act.

23 Sec. 14. Section 153.29, Code 1997, is amended to read as 24 follows:

25 153.29 ORDER STANDS DURING REVIEW.

Notwithstanding the terms of the Iowa administrative procedure Act, <u>chapter 17A</u>, the order of the board <u>of dental</u> <u>examiners or the board of dental hygiene examiners</u> rejecting yuch application, and refusing to renew such license, shall remain in force and effect until such petition for judicial review is finally determined and disposed of upon the merits and no new or temporary license shall be issued to the applicant pending such disposition.

1 153.30 REINSTATEMENT -- EXAMINATION.

2 Any former licensee whose application for renewal of 3 license has been rejected by the board of dental examiners or 4 the board of dental hygiene examiners and who has not 5 successfully prosecuted a proceeding for judicial review 6 therefrom as herein provided shall not thereafter receive such 7 license or renewal thereof unless same such license or renewal 8 shall be granted by the board and upon payment of the renewal 9 fees then due. Said The board may require examination of the 10 former licensee, in which case the former licensee shall pay 11 the examination fees provided by law. Sec. 16. 3 Sec. 19. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 153.34A REFERENCES TO BOARDS. 4 All references to "board" within this chapter refer to the 5 board of dental examiners for dentists and to the board of 6 dental hygiene examiners for dental hygienists. The board of 7 dental hygiene examiners shall act only on matters pertaining 8 to dental hygienists, the licensure, discipline, and education 9 of dental hygienists, and the practice of dental hygiene. 10 Sec. 20. Section 272C.1, subsection 6, Code 1997, is 11 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

NEW PARAGRAPH. cc. The board of dental hygiene examiners,
 13 created pursuant to chapter 147.

14 Sec. 21. CURRENT RULES AND LICENSES.

15 1. All rules pertaining to dental hygiene and dental 16 hygienists in force at the time the board of dental hygiene 17 examiners is created shall remain in force and be enforced by 18 the board of dental hygiene examiners until amended or 19 repealed by the board of dental hygiene examiners.

20 2. All persons holding a valid dental hygiene license 21 granted under the authority of the board of dental examiners 22 shall continue to hold such license for its term unless 23 revoked or suspended by the board of dental hygiene examiners 24 pursuant to this chapter.

EXPLANATION

This bill creates a board of dental hygiene examiners reparate and distinct from the board of dental examiners. The hoard of dental hygiene examiners replaces the board of dental examiners as the regulating and licensing board for the practice of dental hygiene.
