A BILL FOR 1 An Act relating to community college operations including the duties of the board of directors of each community college and creating a legislative task force to study certain matters relating to community colleges. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 260C.14, Code 1997, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 22. Annually submit to the department of
- 4 education by August 15, on forms designed by the department of
- 5 education in consultation with the community colleges,
- 6 information relating to the fiscal year ending the previous
- 7 June 30, which shall include, but is not limited to, the
- 8 following:
- 9 a. The number of full-time and part-time students enrolled
- 10 in each program offered by the community college, listed by
- 11 program.
- 12 b. The number of and any appropriate demographic
- 13 information, including salaries, of full-time and part-time
- 14 staff, including the faculty, administration, and support
- 15 personnel employed at each community college.
- 16 c. The full-time equivalent total of persons employed as
- 17 identified in paragraph "b".
- 18 d. Tuition charges, fees, and other costs payable to the
- 19 community college by a student.
- 20 e. The types of degrees granted by the community college
- 21 and the numbers of students receiving these degrees.
- 22 f. The amounts of revenues and expenditures from state
- 23 financial aid, federal funds, tax levies, projects authorized
- 24 under chapters 260E and 260F, tuition, bonds, other local
- 25 sources, foundation sources, and donations and gifts that have
- 26 been accepted by the governing board of a community college.
- 27 g. An inventory of buildings and facilities owned and
- 28 leased by the community college, and any related operation and
- 29 maintenance costs.
- 30 h. Infrastructure plans, which shall include, but are not
- 31 limited to, the amounts expended on renovation and
- 32 construction, and any future plans and projected costs for
- 33 expansion.
- 34 The department of education may withhold from a community
- 35 college any state financial assistance appropriated to the

- 1 department for allocation to the community college if the
- 2 community college fails to substantially meet the requirements
- 3 of this subsection.
- 4 Sec. 2. LEGISLATIVE STUDY.
- 5 l. There is created a legislative task force to study the
- 6 need for the community colleges to operate effectively and
- 7 efficiently as a state system, while recognizing the strong
- 8 local character of community colleges. The study shall
- 9 include, but is not limited to, a review of the governance
- 10 system of the community colleges; ongoing collaboration among
- 11 the community colleges; changes necessary to enhance the
- 12 accountability of community colleges; the relationships
- 13 between community colleges and local school districts; the
- 14 relationships between community colleges, the department of
- 15 education, and the state board of education; and the
- 16 relationship between community colleges and other accredited
- 17 postsecondary institutions in Iowa.
- 18 2. Membership on the task force shall consist of the
- 19 following:
- 20 a. Three voting members from the senate to be appointed by
- 21 the majority leader of the senate in consultation with the
- 22 president and the minority leader.
- 23 b. Three voting members from the house of representatives
- 24 to be appointed by the speaker of the house in consultation
- 25 with the minority leader.
- 26 c. Three voting members to be chosen by legislative
- 27 members on the task force.
- 28 d. The director of the department of education, or the
- 29 director's designee, who shall serve as a nonvoting, ex
- 30 officio member.
- 31 The chairperson and vice chairperson of the task force
- 32 shall be chosen from among the voting nonlegislative members
- 33 by a majority vote of the legislative members. Nonlegislative
- 34 members of the task force shall be reimbursed for actual and
- 35 necessary expenses incurred in performance of the duties.

- 1 Expense moneys paid to nonlegislative members shall be paid
- 2 from funds appropriated to the task force. Legislative
- 3 members of the task force shall receive payment pursuant to
- 4 sections 2.10 and 2.12.
- 5 3. From the moneys appropriated to the general assembly in
- 6 section 2.12, not more than \$90,000 for the fiscal year
- 7 beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1998, shall be
- 8 allocated to the task force created in subsection 1 for
- 9 purposes of the payment of services of a consultant to assist
- 10 the task force, or for the task force to contract for an
- 11 independent study of the issues identified in subsection 1.
- 12 4. The task force shall submit its findings and
- 13 recommendations to the general assembly by December 1, 1997.
- 14 Staff assistance to the task force shall be provided by the
- 15 legislative service bureau and the legislative fiscal bureau
- 16 and the staffs shall cooperate with and coordinate the work of
- 17 the task force with the consultant if a consultant is
- 18 employed.

19 EXPLANATION

- 20 This bill requires the boards of directors of the community
- 21 colleges to provide certain specified information relating to
- 22 programs, buildings, students, and community college staff
- 23 members annually to the department of education and creates a
- 24 legislative task force to study the need for the community
- 25 colleges to operate effectively and efficiently as a state
- 26 system, while recognizing the strong local character of
- 27 community colleges.
- 28 The bill grants authority to the department of education to
- 29 withhold from a community college any state financial
- 30 assistance appropriated to the department for allocation to
- 31 the community college if the community college fails to
- 32 substantially meet the information requirements.
- 33 The bill creates a legislative task force to study the need
- 34 for the community colleges to operate effectively and
- 35 efficiently as a state system, while recognizing the strong

- 1 local character of community colleges. Under the bill, the
- 2 legislative task force study shall include, but is not limited
- 3 to, a review of the governance system of the community
- 4 colleges; changes to enhance the accountability of community
- 5 colleges; ongoing collaboration among the community colleges;
- 6 the relationship between community colleges and local school
- 7 districts; the relationship between community colleges, the
- 8 department of education, and the state board of education; and
- 9 the relationship between community colleges and other
- 10 accredited postsecondary institutions in Iowa.
- Membership on the task force shall consist of three voting
- 12 members from the senate to be appointed by the president of
- 13 the senate in consultation with the minority leader, three
- 14 voting members from the house of representatives to be
- 15 appointed by the speaker of the house in consultation with the
- 16 minority leader, and three voting members to be chosen by
- 17 legislative members on the task force. The director of the
- 18 department of education, or the director's designee, shall
- 19 serve as a nonvoting, ex officio member.
- 20 From the moneys appropriated for legislative expenses, the
- 21 bill allocates not more than \$90,000 for the 1997-1998 fiscal
- 22 year to the task force for the payment of services of a
- 23 professional facilitator to assist the task force, or for the
- 24 task force to contract for an independent study of the issues
- 25 identified in the bill.
- The task force shall submit its findings and
- 27 recommendations to the general assembly meeting in 1998.
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
