16 is received by the commissioner after the deadline, or if the $i 7$ registration form is received by the commissioner no later 18 than five $\mathrm{i} . \mathrm{m}$. on the last day to register to vote for an 19 ejection, even if it is postmarked after the Effeenth thirty20 fifth day before the election.

Section 1. Section 48A.9, subsection 1, Code 1997, is amended to read as follows:

1. Registration closes at five pom. eleven thirty days before each election excepe-primary-and-generai-etections. Por-ptimary-and-generat-ełections;-registration-cłoses-at-£ive p-m-ten-dags-before-the-eまection. An eligible elector may register during the time registration is closed in the elector's precinct but the registration shall not become effective until registration opens again in the elector's 0 precinct.

EXPLANATION
This bill changes the deadline to register to vote in an election from 10 days before primary and general elections and 11 days before all other elections to 30 days before all elections. The bill also provides that a mailed registration must be postmarked no later than 35 days before the election to be considered on time if it arrives after the deadline.
