1 Section 1. Section 455C.2, subsection 2, Code 1997, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 2. In addition to the refund value provided in subsection  
4 1 of this section, a dealer, or person operating a redemption  
5 center who redeems empty beverage containers or a dealer agent  
6 shall be reimbursed by the distributor required to accept the  
7 empty beverage containers an amount which is ~~one-cent~~ two  
8 cents per container. A dealer, dealer agent, or person  
9 operating a redemption center may compact empty metal beverage  
10 containers with the approval of the distributor required to  
11 accept the containers.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill requires all beverage distributors who are  
14 required to accept empty beverage containers to reimburse a  
15 dealer, a person operating a redemption center, or a dealer  
16 agent an amount equal to two cents for each empty beverage  
17 container accepted by the distributor. The current  
18 reimbursement rate is one cent per container.
