Section 1. NEW SECTION. 99F.5A MORATORIUM FOR ISSUANCE OF LICENSES FOR EXCURSION GAMBLING BOATS AND ON THE NUMBER AND TYPE OF GAMBLING GAMES.

1. The total number of licenses issued to conduct gambling games on excursion gambling boats pursuant to this chapter
shall not exceed ten until July 1, 2003.
2. Notwithstanding subsection 1, the following actions may be taken during the moratorium from July 1, 1998, until July 1, 2003, with the approval of the commission:
a. A licensed excursion gambling boat may move to a new location within the same county.
b. A licensed excursion gambling boat and its facilities may be sold and a new license may be issued for operation in the same county.
c. If a license to conduct gambling games on an excursion gambling boat is surrendered, not renewed, or revoked, a new license may be issued for operation in the same county.
3. During the moratorium from July 1, 1998, until July 1, 2003, the commission shall not authorize any of the following:
a. An increase in the number or type of gambling games or the number of slot machines on excursion gambling boats which are located and operated on the Mississippi or Missouri rivers.
b. A number of slot machines at a pari-mutuel racetrack which is greater than the number authorized on or before July 1, 1998.

Sec. 2. Section 99F.7, subsection 1, Code 1997, is amended to read as follows:

1. If the commission is satisfied that this chapter and its rules adopted under this chapter applicable to licensees have been or will be complied with, the commission shall issue a license for a period of not more than three years to an applicant to own a gambling game operation and to an applicant to operate an excursion gambling boat. The commission shall decide which of the gambling games authorized under this chapter it will permit. The commission shall decide the number, location, and type of excursion gambling boats licensed under this chapter for operation on the rivers, lakes, and reservoirs of this state. However, after July 1, 2003, the commission shall issue a new license for an excursion gambling boat operation only if the excursion gambling boat operates on the Mississippi or Missouri river. The license shall set forth the name of the licensee, the type of license granted, the place where the excursion gambling boats will operate and dock, and the time and number of days during the excursion season and the off season when gambling may be conducted by the licensee. The commission shall not allow a licensee to conduct gambling games on an excursion gambling boat while docked during the off season if the licensee does not operate gambling excursions for a minimum number of days during the excursion season. The commission may delay the commencement of the excursion season at the request of a licensee.

EXPLANATION
The bill imposes a moratorium on the issuing of licenses to conduct gambling games on excursion gambling boats until July

222 1, 2003, and freezes the number of excursion gambling boat
223 licenses at 10. The moratorium includes the number and types
224 of gambling games and the number of slot machines which can be
225 operated on an excursion gambling boat and the number of slot
226 machines which can be operated at a pari-mutuel racetrack.
227 The moratorium on the number and types of gambling games
228 including the number of slot machines operated on excursion
229 gambling boats applies only to the excursion gambling boats
230 operated on the Mississippi or Missouri river.
31 During the moratorium, an excursion gambling boat may be 232 sold and a new license may be issued in the same county. The
233 operation of an excursion gambling boat may be relocated
234 within a county with the commission's approval and the
235 commission may reissue for the same county a license that is
31 surrendered, not renewed, or revoked.
32 After July 1, 2003, the commission shall issue new licenses
33 for excursion gambling boat operations only if the excursion
34 gambling boat operates on the Mississippi or Missouri river.
