- 1 Section 1. Section 321J.2, subsection 8, Code 1997, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 8. The In addition to any other fine or penalty imposed
- 4 under this chapter, the court shall order a defendant
- 5 convicted of or receiving a deferred judgment for a violation
- 6 of this section to make restitution-in-an-amount-not-to
- 7 exceed-two-thousand-dollars, for damages resulting directly
- 8 from the violation according to the following:
- 9 a. To the victim, according to chapter 910. An amount
- 10 paid pursuant to this restitution portion of the order shall
- 11 be credited toward any adverse judgment in a subsequent civil
- 12 proceeding arising from the same occurrence. However, other
- 13 than establishing a credit, a restitution proceeding pursuant
- 14 to-this-section related to this portion of the order shall not

- 29 removing the \$2,000 limitation on victim restitution owed by a
- 30 convicted drunk driver, and making restitution available to
- 31 any public agency for the costs of emergency response services
- 32 related to the acts underlying the drunk driving conviction,
- 33 up to \$500 per agency per response.
