1 Section 1. Section 256.11, subsection 5, paragraph j,
2 unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1997, is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 One unit of health education which shall include personal
5 health; food and nutrition; environmental health; safety and
6 survival skills; cardiopulmonary resuscitation procedures;
7 consumer health; family life; human growth and development;
8 substance abuse and nonuse; emotional and social health;
9 health resources; and prevention and control of disease,
10 including sexually transmitted diseases and acquired immune
11 deficiency syndrome.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill requires the minimum program for health education
14 of students in grades nine through 12 to include
15 cardiopulmonary resuscitation procedures.

16 The bill amends Code section 256.11, which provides for
17 educational standards and minimum educational program
18 requirements.
