BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 478.13, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1997, is amended to read as follows:

Any person, firm, or corporation owning a franchise granted under this chapter or previously existing law, desiring to acquire extensions of such franchise, may petition the utilities board in the manner provided for the granting of a franchise and the same proceeding shall be had conducted in the same manner as on an original application, including the assessing of costs provided by section 478.4 except-that-in the-event. If the extension of franchise is sought for all lines in a given county or counties, the published notice need not contain a general description of the lands and highways traversed by the lines, but in lieu thereof of containing such description the petitioner may have-on-file-at-its-offices-in the-county-or-counties-affected offer to provide to any interested party, free of charge and within ten working days, a current, accurate map showing the location of the lines for which the franchise extension is sought, -said-map-to-be available-for-examination-by-any-interested-party,-and-the. The public notice shall advise the citizens of the county or counties affected of the location-and availability of such map. If this alternate procedure is not followed then the publication of the description of the lands and highways traversed by the lines shall be done in the manner as in an original application for franchise. In any event an extension under this section will shall be granted only for a valid, existing franchise and the lands, roads, or streams covered thereby by the franchise over, through, or upon which electric transmission lines have in fact been erected or constructed and are in use or operation at the time of the application for the extension of franchise.
