1 An Act providing for the establishment of an appeal reimbursement
2 fund by the school budget review committee, and making an
3 appropriation.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 257.31, Code Supplement 1997, is
- 2 amended by adding the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 18. a. The committee shall establish an
- 4 appeal reimbursement fund. There shall be appropriated
- 5 annually from the general fund of the state to the committee
- 6 an amount sufficient to establish and administer the fund.
- 7 The purpose of the appeal reimbursement fund shall be to
- 8 provide reimbursement to local school districts which are a
- 9 party to a civil action in which an appeal has been filed of
- 10 up to fifty percent of the fees and costs associated with the
- 11 commencement, prosecution, or defense of the action.
- 12 b. A school district may apply to the school budget review
- 13 committee for reimbursement from the fund after fees and costs
- 14 resulting from the commencement, prosecution, or defense of an
- 15 action have been assessed against the school district by the
- 16 court. The determination as to whether, and to what extent, a
- 17 school district shall receive a distribution from the appeal
- 18 reimbursement fund shall be in the discretion of the school
- 19 budget review committee, based on the circumstances of the
- 20 case and the extent to which the committee determines that the
- 21 position of the school district in the prosecution or defense
- 22 of an action on appeal was justified. In making this
- 23 determination, the committee shall primarily evaluate the
- 24 merits of the school district's case, rather than the
- 25 probability of a favorable outcome on the school district's
- 26 behalf.
- 27 c. A school district may also submit a request for a
- 28 preliminary determination by the school budget review
- 29 committee of the merits of a prospective appeal, prior to
- 30 making a decision regarding whether or not to proceed with the
- 31 appeal. A preliminary determination by the committee that the
- 32 position of the school district appears justified may be
- 33 utilized by a school district as one factor in assessing
- 34 whether or not to proceed with an appeal, but shall not
- 35 guarantee a distribution from the appeal reimbursement fund.

d. The school budget review committee shall establish
 appeal reimbursement fund application forms and procedures by

3 rule. The committee shall include information regarding

4 applications to and distributions from the appeal

5 reimbursement fund in its annual report to the general

6 assembly pursuant to section 257.31, subsection 2.

7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill provides for the establishment of an appeal

9 reimbursement fund by the school budget review committee and

10 appropriates an amount annually to maintain and administer the

11 fund. The purpose of the appeal reimbursement fund shall be

12 to provide reimbursement to local school districts which are a

13 party to a civil action in which an appeal has been filed of

14 up to 50 percent of the fees and costs associated with the

15 commencement, prosecution, or defense of the action.

16 The bill provides that a school district may apply to the

17 school budget review committee for reimbursement after fees

18 and costs have been assessed against the school district by

19 the court. The determination as to whether, and to what

20 extent, a distribution shall be received shall be

21 discretionary with the school budget review committee, based

22 on the circumstances of the case and the extent to which the

23 committee determines that the position of the school district

24 in the prosecution or defense of an action on appeal was

25 justified. The bill provides that a school district may also

26 submit a request for a preliminary, nonbinding determination

27 by the school budget review committee of the merits of a

28 prospective appeal.

29 The bill additionally provides that the school budget

30 review committee shall establish application procedures by

31 rule, and shall include information regarding applications to

32 and distributions from the appeal reimbursement fund in its

33 annual report to the general assembly.
