1 Section 1. FEDERAL ENTERPRISE COMMUNITY JOB TRAINING PILOT  
2 PROJECT. The department of economic development shall  
3 establish and administer a job training pilot project  
4 targeting high risk youths and families residing in an area  
5 which meets the requirements for eligibility for an urban or  
6 rural enterprise community under Title XIII of the federal  
7 Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1993. The department  
8 shall determine eligibility requirements which shall be based  
9 on income level and education level. The department shall  
10 coordinate with cities and counties with federal urban or  
11 rural enterprise communities to identify eligible persons.  
12 The department of economic development shall coordinate with  
13 and receive assistance from community colleges and the  
14 department of workforce development in developing and  
15 providing job training benefits.

16 Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated from the  
17 general fund of the state to the department of economic  
18 development for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1998, and  
19 ending June 30, 1999, the following amount, or so much thereof  
20 as is necessary, to be used for the purposes designated:

21 For the federal enterprise community job training pilot  
22 project, including salaries, support, maintenance, and  
23 miscellaneous purposes:

24 ..... \$ 200,000

25 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated in this  
26 section which remain unexpended or unobligated on June 30,  
27 1999, shall not revert to the general fund of the state but  
28 shall remain available for expenditure for the purposes  
29 designated in this section in the succeeding fiscal year.

30 EXPLANATION

31 This bill requires the department of economic development  
32 to establish and administer a job training pilot project  
33 targeting high risk youths and families residing in areas  
34 designated as federal urban or rural enterprise communities.  
35 Eligibility shall be based on income and education levels and

1 the department shall coordinate with and receive assistance  
2 from community colleges and the department of workforce  
3 development in developing and providing job training benefits.  
4 The bill appropriates \$200,000 to the department of economic  
5 development to establish and administer the pilot project.  
6 Moneys remaining unexpended or unobligated on June 30, 1999,  
7 shall not revert.
