**A BILL FOR**

2 juvenile detention facilities and providing an applicability  
3 date provision.

1 Section 1. Section 282.31, subsection 1, Code 1997, is  
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. c. Notwithstanding paragraph "a", for  
4 purposes of juvenile detention home educational program  
5 services provided by an area education agency pursuant to  
6 section 282.30, subsection 1, paragraph "a", the deductions  
7 made from state foundation aid pursuant to paragraph "a" shall  
8 be made solely from the state foundation aid attributable to  
9 the portion of weighted enrollment that is additional  
10 enrollment because of special education determined pursuant to  
11 section 257.6, subsection 3. The portion that shall be  
12 deducted for a particular school district shall correspond to  
13 the ratio that the additional weighted enrollment because of  
14 special education for the school district bears to the total  
15 additional weighted enrollment because of special education  
16 for all school districts in the state for the budget year in  
17 which the deduction is made.

18 Sec. 2. This Act applies to school years beginning on or  
19 after July 1, 1999.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill provides for a change in the manner in which  
22 amounts transferred by the department of revenue and finance  
23 to an area education agency for educational services provided  
24 to a child living in a juvenile detention facility, as defined  
25 in Code section 232.2, subsection 32, are deducted in the  
26 subsequent fiscal year from the state foundation aid paid to a  
27 school district. Code section 282.31, subsection 1, paragraph  
28 "a", currently provides that the department of revenue and  
29 finance shall pay the approved budget amount for juvenile  
30 detention facility education services provided by an area  
31 education agency to the agency from the moneys appropriated  
32 under Code section 257.16 for foundation aid and supplementary  
33 aid. The amounts paid shall be deducted from the state  
34 foundation aid paid under Code section 257.16 to all school  
35 districts in the state during the subsequent fiscal year, in

1 the ratio that the budget enrollment for the budget year for a  
2 school district bears to the total budget enrollment in the  
3 state for that budget year. The bill provides that the amount  
4 deducted shall be deducted solely from the state foundation  
5 aid paid under Code section 257.16 which is attributable to  
6 the portion of weighted enrollment that is additional  
7 enrollment because of special education. The bill provides  
8 that the amount deducted for a particular school district  
9 shall be in the ratio that the additional weighted enrollment  
10 for special education for the district bears to the total  
11 additional weighted enrollment for special education for all  
12 school districts in the state.

13 The bill applies to school years beginning on or after July  
14 1, 1999.
