A fiscal note for House File 2437 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

House File 2437 changes the count for pupils enrolled in kindergarten less than full-time from 1.0 to 0.8 in FY 2008, 0.6 in FY 2009, and 0.5 in FY 2010. This count is used for the school aid formula.

## ASSUMPTIONS

1. Allowable growth is $3.0 \%$ every year so state cost per pupil is $\$ 5,238$ for FY 2008, $\$ 5,395$ for FY 2009, $\$ 5,557$ for FY 2010.
2. State cost per pupil is used as the district cost per pupil.
3. Kindergarten enrollment and programs will remain constant.
4. Foundation level remains at $87.5 \%$.
5. Estimated number of part-time kindergarten pupils is 15,447 .

## FISCAL IMPACT

House File 2437 is estimated to reduce school district budgets by $\$ 16.2$ million in FY 2008, $\$ 33.3$ million in FY 2009 , and $\$ 42.9$ million in FY 2010. The Bill is estimated to reduce school foundation formula state aid by $\$ 14.2$ million in FY 2008, \$29.1 million in FY 2009, and \$37.5 million in FY 2010.
