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A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the standard uniforms of sheriffs and deputy sheriffs.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- Section 1. Section 331.657, subsection 3, Code 1997, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: The colors and design of the standard uniform for the 4 sheriffs and deputy sheriffs shall be designated by rule of 5 the commissioner of public safety after consideration of the 6 recommendations of the/Iowa state association of sheriffs and 7 deputy sheriffs. The uniform shall include standard shirts, 8 shoulder patches, badges, nameplates, hats, trousers, 9 neckties, jackets, socks, shoes and boots, and leather goods. 10 The uniforms shall be readily distinguishable from the 11 uniforms of other law enforcement agencies of the state. The 12 rules shall allow for appropriate individual county 13 designations on the uniforms. The rules shall be adopted and 14 may be amended in compliance with chapter 17A. Sec. 2. IMPLEMENTATION OF ACT. Section 25B.2, subsection 16 3, shall not apply to this Act. 17 **EXPLANATION** 18 This bill adds shirt to the clothing items included as part 19 of the standard uniform of a sheriff or deputy sheriff. 20 The bill may create a state mandate as provided in chapter The bill makes inapplicable Code section 25B.2, 22 subsection 3, which would relieve a political subdivision from 23 complying with a state mandate if funding for the cost of the 24 state mandate is not provided or specified.
