1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 461A.3A RESTORE THE OUTDOORS
2 PROGRAM.

3 1. The department shall establish a restore the outdoors
4 program. The purpose of the program is to provide major
5 maintenance and infrastructure improvements to existing state
6 parks and other public facilities managed by the department.
7 As part of the program, the department may grant moneys to
8 cities and counties that provide overall maintenance to former
9 state-owned park facilities that had originally been
10 constructed by the federal works progress administration, or
11 successor agency, or the federal civilian conservation corps
12 and which are listed on the federal historical registry.

13 2. There is appropriated from the rebuild Iowa
14 infrastructure fund created in section 8.57, subsection 5, for
15 each fiscal year of the fiscal period beginning July 1, 1997,
16 and ending June 30, 2001, the sum of three million dollars to
17 the department for use in the restore the outdoors program.
18 Notwithstanding section 8.33, unencumbered or unobligated
19 moneys remaining at the end of the fiscal year shall not
20 revert but shall remain available for expenditure during the
21 following fiscal year for purposes of the restore the outdoors
22 program.

23 The department shall provide in its annual budget
24 documentations to the governor and general assembly a report
25 on the use of moneys under the program since the last report
26 and the projected use of future moneys.

27 EXPLANATION

28 The bill creates a restore the outdoors program within the
29 department of natural resources and appropriates \$3,000,000
30 for each fiscal year over a four-year period. The purpose of
31 the program is to provide major maintenance and infrastructure
32 improvements to existing state parks and other public
33 facilities managed by the department of natural resources.
34 Grants are also available to cities and counties that provide
35 maintenance to former state-owned park facilities built by

1 certain federal agencies which are on the federal historical
2 registry. The money is appropriated from the rebuild Iowa
3 infrastructure fund.
