4	BE	IT	ENACTE	D BY	THE	GENERAL	ASSEMBLY	OF	THE	STATE	OF	IOWA:
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н.г. 25 Section 1. There is appropriated from the state fish and 2 game protection fund to the division of fish and wildlife of 3 the department of natural resources for the fiscal year

4 beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1998, the 5 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, except 6 that if revenues from the income tax refund checkoff credited 7 to the state fish and game protection fund do not equal or 8 exceed \$1,500,000, the amount of the deficiency is 9 appropriated from the general fund of the state instead of 10 from the state fish and game protection fund, to be used for 11 the purposes designated:

12 To develop and support a comprehensive nongame wildlife-13 oriented education program to be implemented through the 14 schools, county conservation boards, and the department of 15 natural resources.

To enhance opportunities for personal contact with, and the 16 17 public's appreciation for, all types of wildlife by developing 18 facilities for public appreciation of wildlife.

To protect, develop, and manage habitats to enhance nongame 19 20 populations on public and private lands through habitat 21 development and acquisition.

22 To develop and support nongame wildlife species management, 23 research, and surveys.

To match moneys appropriated by the United States or an 24 25 agency, commission, or department of the United States if the 26 appropriation of moneys by a state is a condition of the state 27 or an agency, commission, or department of the state, 28 receiving federal moneys.

To adopt programs by the division of fish and wildlife of 29 30 the department of natural resources relating to a wildlife 31 diversity initiative by rule pursuant to chapter 17A: 32 .... ..... \$ 1,500,000 33 EXPLANATION This bill appropriates \$1,500,000 from the state fish and 34 35 game protection fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1,



1 1997, and ending June 30, 1998, to the department of natural 2 resources to establish a wildlife diversity initiative, from 3 the combination of revenues produced by the income tax refund 4 checkoff credited to the state fish and game protection fund 5 and the general fund of the state.

6 Specifically, if revenues from the income tax refund 7 checkoff credited to the state fish and game protection fund 8 do not equal or exceed \$1,500,000, the amount of the 9 deficiency is appropriated from the general fund of the state 10 instead of from the state fish and game protection fund.

11 The bill provides that the wildlife diversity initiative 12 shall develop and support a comprehensive wildlife-oriented 13 education program; enhance opportunities for personal contact 14 with, and the public's appreciation for, all types of wildlife 15 by developing facilities for public appreciation of wildlife; 16 protect, develop, and manage habitats to enhance nongame 17 populations on public and private lands through habitat 18 development and acquisition; and develop and support nongame 19 wildlife species management, research, and surveys, and match 20 moneys appropriated by the United States or an agency, 21 commission, or department of the United States if the 22 appropriation of moneys by a state is a condition of the state 23 or an agency, commission, or department of the state, 24 receiving federal moneys.

The bill authorizes the division of fish and wildlife of the department of natural resources to adopt programs relating to a wildlife diversity initiative by rule.

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
