House File 269, as amended by H-1161, provides a 100.0% regular program budget guarantee in the School Foundation Aid Formula for FY 1998 and FY 1999.

ASSUMPTIONS

- 1. The allowable growth factor for FY 1998 is 3.5%.
- 2. Estimates are based on 379 school districts, the four districts reorganizing in FY 1998 are estimated separately.

FISCAL IMPACT

House File 269, as amended by H-1161, is estimated to increase the FY 1998 property taxes by \$2,457,720 compared to current law. At 3.5% allowable growth, 60 school districts are on the 100.0% budget guarantee.
