A BILL FOR 1 An Act requiring executive branch agencies to implement a budgeting process which utilizes certain performance measures. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 8.35B BUDGETING FOR RESULTS.
- 2 1. For the purposes of this section, unless the context
- 3 otherwise requires, the term "budgeting for results" means the
- 4 budgeting process which includes steps for identifying and
- 5 measuring desired results by use of results-oriented
- 6 performance measures. Under budgeting for results the
- 7 performance measures are developed by a department or
- 8 establishment in collaboration with the department of
- 9 management and the legislative fiscal bureau for a program
- 10 administered by the department or establishment.
- 11 2. If a new program commences on or after July 1, 1997,
- 12 under a department or establishment or the source of funding
- 13 for a program administered by a department or establishment is
- 14 changed from the source of funding used in the previous fiscal
- 15 year, the program shall be included in budgeting for results.
- 3. Commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000,
- 17 all programs administered by departments and establishments
- 18 shall be included in budgeting for results.
- 19 4. The departments and establishments utilizing budgeting
- 20 for results, shall collect data as determined by the
- 21 department of management in collaboration with the legislative
- 22 fiscal bureau, for use in evaluating the programs included in
- 23 budgeting for results. The data shall measure the
- 24 effectiveness of a program in achieving the stated desired
- 25 results. Analysis of the data and evaluations of the
- 26 effectiveness of a program in achieving the desired results
- 27 shall be submitted by the departments and establishments to
- 28 the governor and general assembly for use in making budgetary
- 29 and policy decisions.
- 30 EXPLANATION
- 31 This bill requires executive branch agencies to implement a
- 32 new budgeting process.
- 33 New Code section 8.35B requires the departments under the
- 34 executive branch of government to implement "budgeting for
- 35 results", a term defined in the section.

The process involves a department, in collaboration with 2 the department of management and the legislative fiscal 3 bureau, developing results-oriented performance measures for 4 the programs administered by the department. If a program is 5 created on or after July 1, 1997, or if the source of funding 6 for the program is changed from that used in the previous 7 fiscal year, the program is to be included in "budgeting for 8 results". Commencing with fiscal year 2000-2001, all programs 9 under the departments of the executive branch are to utilize 10 "budgeting for results".
