## A BILL FOR

1 An Act requiring a county treasurer to refuse to renew a vehicle registration if the person applying for renewal owes restitution in any county. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: 

Section 1. Section 321.40, unnumbered paragraph 4, Code 2 1997, is amended to read as follows: The county treasurer shall refuse to renew the registration 4 of a vehicle registered to a person when notified that-the 5 person-has-not-paid-restitution-as-defined-under-section 6 910-17-subsection-47-to-the-clerk-of-the-court-located-within 7 that-county by the department through the distributed 8 teleprocessing network that the person has not paid 9 restitution as defined under section 910.1, subsection 4, to a 10 clerk of court located in this state. The judicial department 11 shall notify the state department of transportation on a daily 12 basis through the Iowa court information system of the full 13 names and social security numbers of persons whose restitution 14 obligations become delinquent or whose restitution obligations 15 have been cancelled or satisfied. Each-clerk-of-court-subject 16 to-this-section-shall,-by-the-last-day-of-each-month,-notify 17 the-county-treasurer-of-that-county-of-all-persons-who-owe 18 delinquent-restitution: -- Immediately-upon-the-cancellation-or 19 satisfaction-of-the-restitution-the-clerk-of-court-shall 20 notify-the-county-treasurer-if-that-person's-name-appeared-on 21 the-last-list-furnished-to-the-county-treasurer. 22 paragraph does not apply to the transfer of a registration or 23 the issuance of a new registration. The provisions of this 24 paragraph are applicable to counties with a population of 25 twenty-five thousand or more. The provisions of this 26 paragraph shall be applicable to any county with a population 27 of less than twenty-five thousand upon the adoption of a 28 resolution by the county board of supervisors so providing. 29 EXPLANATION 30 This bill provides that a county treasurer shall refuse to 31 renew the vehicle registration of a person who has not paid 32 restitution when the treasurer is notified of that fact by the 33 state department of transportation through the department's

34 distributed teleprocessing network. The judicial department

35 shall notify the state department of transportation on a daily

1 basis through the Iowa court information system of the names 2 and social security numbers of persons whose restitution 3 obligations have become delinquent or have been satisfied or 4 cancelled. Currently, registration renewals are to be refused 5 only when the person owes restitution to the clerk of court in 6 the county where the person seeks to renew the registration.
