A BILL FOR 1 An Act relating to expenses paid to members of the general assembly for service while the general assembly is in session and providing an effective date. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2.10, subsection 1, Code 1997, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- Every member of the general assembly except the
- 4 presiding officer of the senate, the speaker of the house, the
- 5 majority and minority floor leader of each house, and the
- 6 president pro tempore of the senate and speaker pro tempore of
- 7 the house, shall receive an annual salary of twenty thousand
- 8 one hundred twenty dollars for the year 1997 and subsequent
- 9 years while serving as a member of the general assembly. In
- 10 addition, each such member shall receive the sum of eighty six
- 11 dollars-per-day, upon the convening of each regular session of
- 12 the general assembly, an amount for expenses of office, except
- 13 travel, for each-day service while the general assembly is in
- 14 session commencing-with-the-first-day-of-a-legislative-session
- 15 and-ending-with-the-day-of-final-adjournment-of-each
- 16 legislative-session-as-indicated-by-the-journals-of-the-house
- 17 and-senate, except-that-if-the-length-of. The amount received
- 18 shall be nine thousand four hundred sixty dollars for service
- 19 during the first regular session of the general assembly
- 20 exceeds-one-hundred-ten-calendar-days and eight thousand six
- 21 hundred dollars for service during the second regular session
- 22 exceeds-one-hundred-calendar-days,-the-payments-shall-be-made
- 23 only-for-one-hundred-ten-calendar-days-for-the-first-session

- 25 general assembly. Members from Polk county shall receive

1 not more than one time per week during a legislative session. This Act takes effect upon the convening of the 3 Seventy-eighth General Assembly in January 1999. EXPLANATION 5 This bill provides that members of the general assembly 6 shall receive an amount for expenses, upon the convening of 7 each regular session of the general assembly, for service 8 while the general assembly is in regular session regardless of 9 the length of the regular session.
