A BILL FOR

1 An Act making selective service registration of certain
2 individuals a prerequisite for enrollment, and for the receipt
3 of state-sponsored financial aid, at community colleges and
4 institutions of higher learning under the control of the state
5 board of regents, and providing an effective date and
6 applicability date.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 358

1 Section 1. Section 260C.14, Code 1997, is amended by
2 adding the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 22. Prohibit the enrollment of a male
4 individual as a student, and shall not award any individual a
5 state-supported loan, grant, or scholarship, if the individual
6 is between the ages of eighteen and twenty-six years and has
7 not registered with the federal selective service system in
8 accordance with the federal Military Selective Service Act, 50
9 U.S.C. App. 453, as amended. The board shall include as part
10 of the community college admission form a statement of
11 selective service, which shall be filled out by any male
12 applicant between the ages of eighteen and twenty-six years.
13 The statement shall include space for the applicant to record
14 the selective service number assigned to the applicant and
15 shall certify one of the following:

16 a. That the applicant has registered with the selective
17 service system in accordance with the Military Selective
18 Service Act, 50 U.S.C. App. 453, as amended.

19 b. That the applicant is not required to register with the
20 selective service system for one of the following reasons:

21 (1) The applicant is on active duty with the armed forces
22 of the United States other than for training in a reserve or
23 national guard unit.

24 (2) The applicant is a nonimmigrant alien lawfully in the
25 United States in accordance with section 101(a)(15) of the
26 federal Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1101, as
27 amended.

28 (3) The applicant is not a citizen of the United States
29 and is a permanent resident of the trust territory of the
30 Pacific Islands or the Northern Mariana Islands.

31 If the institution enrolls a male applicant who is less
32 than eighteen years of age, the community college shall
33 require the student to file a revised statement of selective
34 service status after reaching the age of eighteen. The
35 community college shall not enroll the student in another

1 semester, or award or renew a state-supported loan, grant, or
2 scholarship to the student until the student submits a
3 statement certifying that the student is registered with the
4 federal selective service system or is exempt from
5 registration. For an applicant not required to register with
6 the federal selective service system, the statement shall
7 include space for certification of nonregistration and for an
8 explanation of the reason for the exemption. The board may
9 require that the statement be accompanied by any documentation
10 the board deems necessary.

11 Sec. 2. Section 262.9, Code 1997, is amended by adding the
12 following new subsection:

13 NEW SUBSECTION. 30. Prohibit the institutions of higher
14 learning under its control from enrolling a male individual as
15 a student, and from awarding the individual a state-supported
16 loan, grant, or scholarship if the individual is between the
17 ages of eighteen and twenty-six years and has not registered
18 with the federal selective service system in accordance with
19 the federal Military Selective Service Act, 50 U.S.C. App.
20 453, as amended. Each institution of higher learning under
21 the control of the regents is directed to include as part of
22 its admission form a statement of selective service, which
23 shall be filled out by any male applicant between the ages of
24 eighteen and twenty-six years. The statement shall include
25 space for the applicant to record the selective service number
26 assigned to the applicant and shall certify one of the
27 following:

28 a. That the applicant has registered with the selective
29 service system in accordance with the Military Selective
30 Service Act, 50 U.S.C. App. 453, as amended.

31 b. That the applicant is not required to register with the
32 selective service system for one of the following reasons:

33 (1) The applicant is on active duty with the armed forces
34 of the United States other than for training in a reserve or
35 national guard unit.

1 (2) The applicant is a nonimmigrant alien lawfully in the
2 United States in accordance with section 101(a)(15) of the
3 federal Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1101, as
4 amended.

5 (3) The applicant is not a citizen of the United States
6 and is a permanent resident of the trust territory of the
7 Pacific Islands or the Northern Mariana Islands.

8 If the institution enrolls a male applicant who is less
9 than eighteen years of age, the institution shall require the
10 student to file a revised statement of selective service
11 status after reaching the age of eighteen. The institution
12 shall not enroll the student in another semester, or award or
13 renew a state-supported loan, grant, or scholarship to the
14 student until the student submits a statement certifying that
15 the student is registered with the federal selective service
16 system or is exempt from registration. For an applicant not
17 required to register with the federal selective service
18 system, the statement shall include space for certification of
19 nonregistration and for an explanation of the reason for the
20 exemption. The board may direct the institutions to require
21 that the statement be accompanied by any documentation the
22 board deems necessary.

23 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
24 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment and applies
25 to individuals applying for admission on or after the
26 effective date of this Act.

27 EXPLANATION

28 This bill directs the state board of regents and the boards
29 of directors for the community colleges to prohibit the
30 institutions of higher learning under their control from
31 enrolling a male individual as a student, and from awarding
32 any individual a state-supported loan, grant, or scholarship,
33 if the individual is between the ages of 18 and 26 years and
34 has not registered with the federal selective service system
35 in accordance with the federal Military Selective Service Act.

1 Each institution or board is directed to include on its
2 admission form a statement of selective service, which shall
3 be filled out by any male applicant between the ages of 18 and
4 26. The statement shall include space for the applicant to
5 record the selective service number assigned to the applicant
6 and to either indicate that the applicant is registered or
7 explain why the applicant is not required to register.

8 A male student who enrolled at less than 18 years of age is
9 required to file a revised statement of selective service
10 status after reaching the age of 18, and until the student
11 does, the student shall not be enrolled in another semester,
12 or awarded, or receive a renewal for, a state-supported loan,
13 grant, or scholarship. For those applicants not required to
14 register with the federal selective service system, the
15 statement shall include space for certification of
16 nonregistration and for an explanation of the reason for the
17 exemption. The board may require that the statements be
18 accompanied by documentation.

19 The bill takes effect upon enactment and applies to
20 individuals applying for admission on or after the date on
21 which the bill takes effect.

16 six years of age and has not registered with the
17 federal selective service system in accordance with
18 the federal Military Selective Service Act, 50 U.S.C.
19 App. 453, as amended.""

22 4. Page 1, by striking lines 21 through 27 and
23 inserting the following:

29 sponsored financial aid"."
