Two members shall be appointed by the board of 9 supervisors, one from its own membership and one elector of 10 the county appointed by the board of supervisors to represent 11 the general public. Two members shall be appointed by the 12 other elective county officers, one from among those elective 13 county officers and one elector of the county to represent the 14 general public. In setting the salary of the county sheriff, the board shall consider setting the sheriff's salary that it is comparable to salaries paid to professional law enforcement administrators and command officers of the Iowa highway safety patrol, the division of criminal investigation of the department of public safety, and city police agencies in this state.
