1 Section 1. Section 216A.5, Code 1997, is amended to read  
2 as follows:

3 216A.5 REPEAL.

4 This chapter is repealed effective July 1, ~~1997~~ 1998.

5 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of  
6 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill provides for the continued operation of the  
9 department of human rights. Iowa Code section 216A.5 provides  
10 that the department of human rights will cease to exist  
11 effective July 1, 1997. The bill extends this provision for  
12 one year, enabling the department to continue its operations  
13 until July 1, 1998. This bill takes effect upon enactment.
