A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the repair and reconstruction of state property, and establishing oversight councils. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

HF 480

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 262.34C REPAIR AND RESTORATION 2 COUNCIL.
- 3 l. a. The board shall establish a repair and restoration
- 4 council which shall be composed of at least five members
- 5 appointed by the board. Members shall be persons with a
- 6 demonstrated interest in the facilities and grounds of
- 7 existing institutions governed by the board, and the
- 8 maintenance of those facilities and grounds. Each member of
- 9 the council shall serve a term of five years, and shall be
- 10 eligible for reappointment. A vacancy on the panel shall be
- 11 filled for the unexpired portion of the regular term in the
- 12 same manner as regular appointments are made.
- 13 b. The board shall reimburse each member for actual
- 14 expenses incurred by the member in performance of the duties
- 15 of the council from moneys available to the board.
- 16 c. A majority of voting members constitutes a quorum, and
- 17 the affirmative vote of a majority present is necessary for
- 18 any action taken by the council, except that a lesser number
- 19 may adjourn a meeting. A majority shall not include any
- 20 member who has a conflict of interest and a statement by a
- 21 member that the member has a conflict of interest is
- 22 conclusive for this purpose. A vacancy in the membership of
- 23 the council does not impair the rights of a quorum to exercise
- 24 all rights and perform all duties of the council.
- 25 d. The council shall meet as needed, but at least twice a
- 26 year. The council shall meet upon call of the chairperson, or
- 27 upon written request of a majority of members of the council.
- 28 2. The council shall advise the board regarding issues and
- 29 recommendations relating to the repair and restoration of
- 30 facilities and grounds of institutions governed by the board,
- 31 and specifically buildings which do not meet federal or state
- 32 fire or safety code requirements.
- 33 3. The council shall develop and update a plan for the
- 34 long-term maintenance of existing facilities and grounds of
- 35 institutions governed by the board, which shall be submitted

- 1 to the board and the general assembly. Each year, the council
- 2 shall report to the board recommendations for repairing and
- 3 restoring existing facilities and grounds that have not been
- 4 maintained and need repair or restoration, which may include
- 5 reconstruction or replacement. Each fifth year the council
- 6 shall submit a list of not more than ten projects for repair
- 7 or restoration. The board shall develop a plan for
- 8 immediately carrying out the repair or restoration projects.
- 9 Each two years, the council must certify that the department
- 10 is carrying out the repair or restoration projects. The board
- 11 shall suspend the acquisition of land or the new construction
- 12 of buildings, until the council certifies that the board is
- 13 carrying out the repair or restoration projects.
- 14 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 455A.12 NATURAL RESOURCE REPAIR AND
- 15 RESTORATION COUNCIL.
- 16 l. a. The natural resource repair and restoration council
- 17 shall be established within the parks and preserves division
- 18 of the department and shall be composed of at least five
- 19 members appointed by the director with approval by the natural
- 20 resource commission. Members shall be persons with a
- 21 demonstrated interest in the maintenance of natural lands, and
- 22 existing facilities and improvements located on natural lands,
- 23 which are dedicated for public use and under the supervision
- 24 of the department. Each member of the council shall serve a
- 25 term of five years, and shall be eligible for reappointment.
- 26 A vacancy on the panel shall be filled for the unexpired
- 27 portion of the regular term in the same manner as regular
- 28 appointments are made.
- 29 b. The department shall reimburse each member for actual
- 30 expenses incurred by the member in performance of the duties
- 31 of the council.
- 32 c. A majority of voting members constitutes a quorum, and
- 33 the affirmative vote of a majority present is necessary for
- 34 any action taken by the council, except that a lesser number
- 35 may adjourn a meeting. A majority shall not include any

- 1 member who has a conflict of interest and a statement by a
- 2 member that the member has a conflict of interest is

- 9 2. The council shall advise the department and the natural
- 10 resource commission, regarding issues and recommendations
- 11 relating to the repair and restoration of existing facilities
- 12 and improvements located on lands which are under the direct
- 13 supervision of the department, including state parks and state
- 14 recreation areas. The council shall consider the condition of
- 15 existing facilities and improvements, including but not
- 16 limited to structures, shelters, picnic tables, playgrounds,
- 17 beaches, trails, campsites, greenbelts, and docks.
- 18 3. The council shall develop and update a plan for the
- 19 long-term maintenance of existing facilities and improvements,
- 20 which shall be submitted to the department and the general
- 21 assembly. Each year, the council shall report to the director
- 22 and the natural resource commission recommendations for
- 23 repairing and restoring existing facilities and improvements
- 24 that have not been maintained and need repair or restoration,
- 25 which may include reconstruction or replacement. Each fifth
- 26 year the council shall submit a list to the department,
- 27 commission, and general assembly of not more than ten projects
- 28 for repair or restoration. The department shall develop a
- 29 plan for immediately carrying out the repair or restoration
- 30 projects. Each two years, the council must certify that the
- 31 department is carrying out the repair or restoration projects.
- 32 The department shall suspend the acquisition of open space
- 33 land as provided in chapter 465A, until the council certifies
- 34 that the department is actively engaged in carrying out the
- 35 repair or reconstruction projects.

Section 465A.2, Code 1997, is amended by adding Sec. 3. 2 the following new subsection: NEW SUBSECTION. 4. The department shall not acquire open 4 space land under this chapter unless the natural resource 5 repair and restoration council certifies that the department 6 has complied with section 455A.12 by carrying out projects for 7 the repair or restoration of facilities or improvements on 8 lands under the supervision of the department. EXPLANATION This bill requires the state board of regents and the 11 department of natural resources to each establish a council to 12 evaluate the maintenance needs of institutions governed by the 13 board and the department. The bill provides procedures for 14 the operation of the councils. A council serves an advisory 15 capacity and is required to establish a long-term maintenance 16 plan and make annual reports to the board or the department. 17 Each fifth year a council must submit a list of not more than 18 10 projects for repair or restoration which the board or 19 department must immediately carry out. Each two years, a 20 council must certify that the board or department is carrying 21 out the repair or restoration projects. The bill restricts 22 the board or department from acquiring land or beginning new 23 construction until the board certifies that the repair or 24 restoration projects are being accomplished. 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33
