## A BILL FOR

1 An Act concerning gender balance for appointive committees of political subdivisions of the state.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: 4

Section 1. Section 69.16A, Code 1997, is amended to read as follows:
69.16A GENDER BALANCE.

All appointive boards, commissions, committees, and councils of the state or a political subdivision of the state, including a city, county, or school district, established by the Code if not otherwise provided by law shall be gender balanced. No person shall be appointed or reappointed to any board, commission, committee, or council established by the Code if that appointment or reappointment would cause the number of members of the board, commission, committee, or council of one gender to be greater than one-half the membership of the board, commission, committee, or council plus one if the board, commission, committee, or council is composed of an odd number of members. If the board, commission, committee, or council is composed of an even number of members, not more than one-half of the membership shall be of one gender. If there are multiple appointing authorities for a board, commission, committee, or council, they shall consult each other to avoid a violation of this section. This-seetion-shałł-not-prohibit-an-individuat-from completing-a-term-being-served-on-June-3өт-ł987- This section shall not prohibit an individual on a board, commission, committee, or council of a political subdivision from completing a term being served on June 30, 1997.

## EXPLANATION

This bill provides that membership on a board, commission, committee, or council of a political subdivision established by the Code shall be gender balanced. A political subdivision includes a city, county, or school district. The bill provides that the gender balance requirements shall not prohibit an individual currently serving on a board, commission, committee, or council of a political subdivision on June 30 , 1997, from completing their term.
