A BILL FOR

1 An Act requiring use of safety belts in truck beds by minors sixteen years of age and younger, making existing penalties applicable, and providing an effective date. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.445, Code 1997, is amended by 1 2 adding the following new subsection: NEW SUBSECTION. 6. A person under the age of seventeen 3 4 shall not ride, and an operator shall not permit a person 5 under the age of seventeen to ride, in the open bed of a motor 6 truck or in an unenclosed area of a motor vehicle on public 7 property or on a highway unless the person is properly seated 8 on a seat and wearing a properly adjusted and fastened safety 9 belt or safety harness which meets the requirements of 10 subsection 1. This subsection does not apply to a motor 11 vehicle operated as part of a parade, a motorcycle or 12 motorized bicycle, a military motor vehicle, an authorized 13 emergency vehicle, an implement of husbandry, or a motor 14 vehicle used to transport hunters and hunting dogs during 15 hunting activities. 16 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect January 1, 17 1998. **EXPLANATION** 18 19 This bill prohibits a person under the age of 17 from 20 riding in the open bed of a truck, while on public property or 21 on a highway without being properly seated and wearing a 22 safety belt. The bill does not apply to persons under the age 23 of 17 who are participating in a parade, motorcycles or 24 motorized bicycles, a military motor vehicle, an authorized 25 emergency vehicle, an implement of husbandry, or a vehicle 26 used for hunting. A violation is punishable as a simple 27 misdemeanor and carries a scheduled fine of \$10. 28 The bill takes effect January 1, 1998. 29 30 31 32 33 34 35
