A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to and making an appropriation to the department for the blind and the department of education to establish

statewide access to newsline for the blind.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1	Section 1. DEPARTMENT FOR THE BLIND. There is
2	appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
3	department for the blind for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
4	1997, and ending June 30, 1998, the following amount, or so
5	much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purpose
6	designated:
7	For the establishment of statewide access to newsline for
8	the blind:
9	\$ 50,000
10	Funds appropriated in this section shall be utilized to
11	assist the department in matching federal funding for the
12	initiation and maintenance of statewide access via the Iowa
13	communications network to the newsline for the blind, a
14	universal system of providing newspapers over the telephone,
15	furnished by the national federation of the blind. This
16	appropriation, together with an appropriation to the
17	department of education, shall permit access to blind and
18	visually impaired individuals throughout the state to the
19	newsline service. The service shall be limited to persons
20	residing in the state who are eligible for the books for the
21	blind and physically handicapped program of the library of
22	Congress.
23	Sec. 2. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. There is appropriated
24	from the general fund of the state to the department of
25	education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1997, and
26	ending June 30, 1998, the following amount, or so much thereof
27	as is necessary, to be used for the purpose designated:
28	For the establishment of statewide access via the Iowa
29	communications network to newsline for the blind:
30	\$ 300,000
31	Funds appropriated in this section shall be utilized to
32	establish statewide Iowa communications network access to the
33	newsline for the blind, a universal system of providing
34	newspapers over the telephone, furnished by the national
35	federation of the blind. The department shall provide access

1 to newsline for the blind to blind and visually impaired 2 persons capable of accessing the Iowa communications network, 3 without cost to the user, and shall coordinate with the Iowa 4 department for the blind to link the Iowa communications 5 network to the office of the department for the blind in Des 6 Moines. The department shall provide assurance to the 7 department for the blind that only blind and visually impaired 8 persons shall have use of the newsline service. 9 shall be limited to persons residing in the state who are 10 eligible for the books for the blind and physically 11 handicapped program of the library of Congress. 12 EXPLANATION 13 This bill provides appropriations to the department for the 14 blind and the department of education to make access to the 15 national federation of the blind's newsline services available 16 to blind and visually impaired residents of the state. 17 newsline service provides for the reading of newspapers over 18 the telephone to blind and visually impaired individuals. 19 department of the blind receives an appropriation of \$50,000 20 for use in matching federal funds to receive the services. 21 The department of education receives an appropriation of 22 \$300,000 to establish the link with the newsline services at 23 the department for the blind's headquarters in Des Moines, and 24 furnish the service at no cost to users. Utilization of the 25 service would be limited to individuals eligible for the books 26 for the blind and physically handicapped program of the 27 library of Congress. 28 29 30 31 32 33
