Section 478.1, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1 2 1997, is amended to read as follows: If the transmission line, wire, or cable is capable of 4 operating only at an electric voltage of less than thirty-four 5 and one-half kilovolts, no franchise is required. However, 6 the utilities board shall retain jurisdiction over all such 7 lines, wires, or cables and-shall-prescribe-the-contents-of-a 8 written-notice-and-map-to-be-timely-provided-to-the-board-and 9 affected-parties-including-owners-of-electric-supply-lines 10 located-within-six-tenths-of-one-mile-of-proposed-construction 11 of-such-lines,-wires-or-cables.
