A BILL FOR 1 An Act relating to child day care by providing for a fee for abuse registry checks of child day care providers and 2 requiring registration of certain family day care homes and 3 making a penalty applicable. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16

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- 1 Section 1. Section 235A.16, Code 1997, is amended by
- 2 adding the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 4. A written request for child abuse
- 4 information involving a provider of child day care, as defined
- 5 in section 237A.1, is subject to a fee of two dollars for each
- 6 central child abuse registry check. If a registry check is
- 7 made regarding an employee of an authorized requester, the fee
- 8 shall be paid by the authorized requester and shall not be
- 9 charged to the employee.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 237A.3, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code
- 11 1997, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 a. A person who operates or establishes a family day care
- 13 home which provides care for four children or less may apply
- 14 to the department for registration under this chapter. A
- 15 person shall not operate or establish a family day care home
- 16 which provides care for five or more children unless the
- 17 person registers under this chapter. The department shall
- 18 issue a certificate of registration upon receipt of a
- 19 statement from the family day care home that the home complies
- 20 with rules adopted by the department. The registration
- 21 certificate shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the
- 22 family day care home, shall state the name of the registrant,
- 23 the number of individuals who may be received for care at any
- 24 one time, and the address of the home, and shall include a
- 25 check list of registration compliances.
- Sec. 3. Section 237A.19, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code
- 27 1997, is amended to read as follows:
- 28 A person who establishes, conducts, manages, or operates a
- 29 family day care home without registering in accordance with
- 30 section 237A.3 or a group day care home without registering
- 31 under this chapter or who operates a an unregistered family
- 32 day care home contrary to section 237A.5, is-guilty-of commits
- 33 a simple misdemeanor. Each day of continuing violation after
- 34 conviction, or notice from the department by certified mail of
- 35 the violation, is a separate offense. A single charge

- 1 alleging continuing violation may be made in lieu of filing
- 2 charges for each day of violation.
- 3 Sec. 4. Section 237A.20, Code 1997, is amended to read as 4 follows:
- 5 237A.20 INJUNCTION.
- 6 A person who establishes, conducts, manages, or operates a
- 7 center without a license, a family day care home without a
- 8 certificate of registration, if required to register in
- 9 accordance with section 237A.3, or a group day care home
- 10 without a certificate of registration may be restrained by
- 11 temporary or permanent injunction. A person who has been
- 12 convicted of a crime against a person or a person with a
- 13 record of founded child abuse may be restrained by temporary
- 14 or permanent injunction from providing unregistered,
- 15 registered, or licensed child day care. The action may be
- 16 instituted by the state, a political subdivision of the state,
- 17 or an interested person.
- 18 EXPLANATION
- 19 This bill relates to child day care by providing for a fee
- 20 for abuse registry checks of child day care providers and
- 21 requiring registration of certain family day care homes.
- 22 Code section 235A.16, relating to requests for child abuse
- 23 information, is amended to apply a fee of \$2 for a child abuse
- 24 registry check involving a child day care provider. If a
- 25 check is performed on an employee of an authorized requester,
- 26 the bill requires the fee to be paid by the authorized
- 27 requester and is not to be charged to the employee.
- 28 Code section 237A.3, relating to registration of family and
- 29 group day care homes, is amended to require registration of a
- 30 family day care home which provides care to five or more
- 31 children. Under current law, registration of family day care
- 32 homes is voluntary. A family day care home which fails to
- 33 register as required by the bill is a simple misdemeanor under
- 34 section 237A.19 and may be restrained by injunction under
- 35 section 237A.20.
