3 11. Have authority to execute an agreement with a
4 governmental entity, including a county, city, sanitary sewer

8 are useful for the collection, disposal, or treatment of

27 EXPLANATION

28 This bill amends Code section 357A.11 which provides for
29 the powers and duties of a board of directors for a rural
30 water district. The bill amends a provision which authorizes
31 a board to execute an agreement with a governmental entity for
32 purposes of managing or administering the governmental
33 entity's wastewater or sewage disposal and treatment
34 facilities. This bill provides that the agreement may provide
35 for acquiring, constructing, maintaining, repairing,

1 improving, or equipping facilities located within the
2 jurisdiction of the governmental entity or the district. The
3 bill provides that this may include financing the associated
4 costs by the issuance of revenue obligations according to
5 procedures applicable to cities.
