A BILL FOR 1 An Act providing for the inspection of earthen storage structures associated with animal feeding operations. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 455B.173, subsection 13, Code 1997, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 13. a. Adopt, modify, or repeal rules relating to the
- 4 construction or operation of animal feeding operations. The
- 5 rules shall include, but are not limited to, minimum manure
- 6 control requirements, requirements for obtaining permits, and
- 7 departmental evaluations of animal feeding operations. The
- 8 department shall not require that a person obtain a permit for
- 9 the construction of an animal feeding operation structure, if
- 10 the structure is part of a small animal feeding operation.
- 11 b. The department shall collect an indemnity fee as
- 12 provided in section 204.3 prior to the issuance of a
- 13 construction permit. The department shall deposit moneys
- 14 collected from indemnity fees in the manure storage indemnity
- 15 fund created in section 204.2.
- 16 c. The department shall not approve a permit for the
- 17 construction of three or more animal feeding operation
- 18 structures, unless the applicant files a statement approved by
- 19 a professional engineer registered pursuant to chapter 542B
- 20 certifying that the construction of the animal feeding
- 21 operation structure will not impede the drainage through
- 22 established drainage tile lines which cross property boundary
- 23 lines unless measures are taken to reestablish the drainage
- 24 prior to completion of construction. The-department-shall
- 25 deposit-moneys-collected-in-indemnity-fees-in-the-manure
- 26 storage-indemnity-fund-created-in-section-204-2-
- 27 d. The department shall issue a permit for an animal
- 28 feeding operation, if an application is submitted according to
- 29 procedures required by the department, and the application
- 30 meets standards established by the department, regardless of
- 31 whether the animal feeding operation is required to obtain
- 32 such a permit. An applicant for a construction permit shall
- 33 not begin construction at the location of a site planned for
- 34 the construction of an animal feeding operation structure,
- 35 until the person has been granted a permit for the

- 1 construction of the structure by the department. The
- 2 department shall make a determination regarding the approval
- 3 or denial of a permit within sixty days from the date that the
- 4 department receives a completed application for a permit.
- 5 However, the sixty-day requirement shall not apply to an
- 6 application, if the applicant is not required to obtain a
- 7 permit in order to construct an animal feeding operation
- 8 structure or to operate an animal feeding operation. The
- 9 department shall deliver a copy or require the applicant to
- 10 deliver a copy of the application for a construction permit to
- 11 the county board of supervisors in the county where the
- 12 confinement feeding operation or confinement feeding operation
- 13 structure subject to the permit is to be located. The
- 14 department shall not approve the application or issue a
- 15 construction permit until thirty days following delivery of
- 16 the application to the county board of supervisors. The
- 17 department shall consider comments from the county board of
- 18 supervisors, regarding compliance by the applicant with the
- 19 legal requirements for the construction of the confinement
- 20 feeding operation structure as provided in this chapter, and
- 21 rules adopted by the department pursuant to this chapter, if
- 22 the comments are delivered to the department within fourteen
- 23 days after receipt of the application by the county board of
- 24 supervisors.
- 25 e. Prior to granting a permit to a person for the
- 26 construction of an animal feeding operation, the department
- 27 may require the installation and operation of a hydrological
- 28 monitoring system for an exclusively earthen manure storage
- 29 structure, if, after an on-site inspection, the department
- 30 determines that the site presents an extraordinary potential
- 31 for groundwater pollution.
- f. A person shall not obtain a permit for the construction
- 33 of a confinement feeding operation, unless the person develops
- 34 a manure management plan as provided in section 455B.203.
- 35 g. The department shall conduct an annual inspection of

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1 each earthen structure, including but not limited to, an 2 anaerobic lagoon or earthen manure storage basin, which is 3 used to store manure from an animal feeding operation, if the 4 structure is required to be constructed pursuant to a permit 5 issued by the department. The department shall not issue a permit to a person h. 7 under this subsection if an enforcement action by the 8 department, relating to a violation of this chapter concerning 9 a confinement feeding operation in which the person has an 10 interest, is pending. The department shall not issue a permit 11 to a person under this subsection for five years after the 12 date of the last violation committed by a person or 13 confinement feeding operation in which the person holds a 14 controlling interest during which the person or operation was 15 classified as a habitual violator under section 455B.191. 16 department shall conduct an annual review of each confinement 17 feeding operation which is a habitual violator and each 18 confinement feeding operation in which a habitual violator 19 holds a controlling interest. The department shall notify 20 persons classified as habitual violators of their 21 classification, additional restrictions imposed upon the 22 persons pursuant to the classification, and special civil 23 penalties that may be imposed upon the persons. 24 shall be sent to the persons by certified mail. 25 EXPLANATION 26 This bill amends Code chapter 455B which provides for the 27 regulation of animal feeding operations. Specifically, the bill provides that the department of 28 29 natural resources must inspect on an annual basis earthen 30 structures used to store manure from an animal feeding

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31 operation, if the structures are required to be constructed 32 pursuant to a permit by the department of natural resources.
