1 Section 1. Section 901.5, Code 1997, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:

3. NEW SUBSECTION. 11. In addition to any sentence or other 4 penalty imposed against the defendant for an offense under 5 chapter 124, the court shall consider the provisions of 21 6 U.S.C. § 862, regarding the denial of federal benefits to drug 7 traffickers and possessors convicted under state or federal 8 law, and may enter an order specifying the range and scope of 9 benefits to be denied to the defendant, according to the 10 provisions of 21 U.S.C. § 862. For the purposes of this 11 subsection, "federal benefit" means the issuance of any grant, 12 contract, loan, professional license, or commercial license 13 provided by an agency of the United States or through the 14 appropriation of funds of the United States, but does not 15 include any retirement, welfare, social security, health, 16 disability, veterans, public housing, or similar benefit for 17 which payments or services are required for eligibility. The 18 Iowa supreme court may adopt rules establishing sentencing 19 guidelines consistent with this subsection and 21 U.S.C. § 20 862. The clerk of the district court shall send a copy of any 21 order issued pursuant to this subsection to the denial of 22 federal benefits program of the United States department of 23 justice, along with any other forms and information required 24 by the department.

EXPLANATION

This bill amends Code section 901.5, to require that a 7 judge sentencing a defendant for a drug-related offense under 28 Code chapter 124 also consider the provisions of 21 U.S.C. § 9 862, a federal statute which gives a court discretion to deny 30 all or selected federal benefits to individuals convicted of 31 any federal or state offense consisting of the distribution or 32 possession of a controlled substance. This bill gives the 33 necessary authority to Iowa courts to apply the federal 34 statute because state courts are generally beyond the 35 jurisdiction of a federal requirement.

The new subsection includes a definition of "federal 1 2 benefit" as it is defined within the federal statute. The 3 subsection also permits the Iowa supreme court to adopt 4 sentencing guidelines consistent with the subsection and the 5 federal statute, and requires that the clerk of the district 6 court send a copy of any order issued pursuant to this 7 subsection to the denial of federal benefits program of the 8 United States department of justice.

The federal statute was enacted under the Anti-Drug Abuse 9 10 Act of 1988, and the denial of federal benefits program is 11 operated within the United States department of justice. 12 Sentencing guidelines for federal courts in conjunction with 13 this statute have existed since 1989. State courts were first 14 notified of the program in 1990.
