FALLON, BARRY, FALCK, BODDICKER, DODERER, 2 BY VEENSTRA, CARROLL, and LORD 3 4 A House Resolution regarding the intent of the House of Representatives that interest groups form an advisory 5 committee to develop recommendations to reduce the 5 frequency of abortions and unplanned pregnancies in 7 8 the state. WHEREAS, tension and discord among representatives 9 10 of reproductive health interests continue to increase; 11 and WHEREAS, a 1994 study of the Alan Guttmacher 12 13 Institute reported that approximately 51 percent of 14 all pregnancies to women in the United States are 15 planned, and of the remainder, approximately 23 16 percent are unplanned, and 27 percent end in abortion; 17 and WHEREAS, unplanned pregnancy in the United States 18 19 is much higher than in comparable developed countries; 20 and WHEREAS, 48 percent of women in the United States 21 22 have had at least one unplanned pregnancy in their 23 lives; and WHEREAS, the highest percentage of unplanned 20 25 pregnancies in the United States is among women ages 26 18-24 and those who are unmarried or low-income, or 27 both; and WHEREAS, 46 percent of unplanned pregnancies end in 28 29 birth while 54 percent end in abortion; NOW THEREFORE, 30 BE IT RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives

l declares that it is the intent of the House of 2 Representatives that an advisory committee be formed 3 during the 1998 interim of the General Assembly to 4 provide an opportunity for the various representatives 5 of reproductive health interests to work together to 6 develop recommendations to reduce the frequency of 7 abortions and unplanned pregnancies in the state. It 3 is the intent of the Rouse of Representatives that the 9 committee be convened by the director of public health 10 and consist of a balance of representatives of a 11 variety of interest groups. 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That any recommendations of 13 the advisory committee shall be submitted to the 14 General Assembly prior to the convening of the General 15 Assembly in January 1999. 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30
