1 Section 1. Section 321.215, subsection 2, Code 1997, is
2 amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

3 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. A person who is determined to be
4 a habitual offender based on a combination of convictions for
5 driving a motor vehicle while the person's motor vehicle
6 license is suspended, revoked, or barred for violations of
7 chapters 321 and 321J may apply for a temporary restricted
8 license under this section if the most recent conviction was
9 for a violation of chapter 321.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill provides that a person who has attained habitual
12 offender status through a combination of convictions for
13 driving while the person's license is suspended, revoked, or
14 barred under either Code chapter 321 and 321J may apply to the
15 district court for a temporary restricted license under Code
16 section 321.215 if the most recent conviction was for a
17 violation of chapter 321.
