

Senate File 189 provides a 100.0% regular program budget guarantee in the School Foundation Aid Formula for FY 1998 and FY 1999.

ASSUMPTIONS

- 1. The allowable growth factor for FY 1998 is 3.5%.
- 2. Estimates are based on 379 school districts, the four districts reorganizing in FY 1998 are estimated separately.

PISCAL IMPACT

Senate File 189 is estimated to increase the FY 1998 property taxes by \$2,457,720 compared to current law. At 3.5% allowable growth, 60 school districts are on the 100.0% budget guarantee.
