A BILL FOR

1.	An Act relating to school infrastructure, establishing a schoo	1
2	infrastructure fund, and making an appropriation.	
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:	
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S.F. 208

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 297A.1 SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE 2 FUND -- APPROPRIATION.
- 3 1. There is appropriated annually from the general fund of 4 the state to the department of education the sum of one
- 5 hundred million dollars to establish, maintain, and administer
- 6 a school infrastructure fund.
- 7 2. Moneys appropriated in subsection 1 shall be allocated
- 8 to school districts throughout the state on a per pupil basis.
- 9 The amount of moneys allocated to school districts shall be in
- 10 the proportion that the basic enrollment of a district bears
- ll to the sum of the basic enrollments of all school districts in
- 12 the state for the budget year.
- 13 3. The department of management shall allocate to each
- 14 school district the amount calculated pursuant to subsection 2
- 15 in one payment on or about October 15 annually, based upon the
- 16 actual enrollment certified to the department of education for
- 17 each school district and forwarded to the department of
- 18 management, taking into consideration the relative budget and
- 19 cash position of the state resources. By October 1 annually,
- 20 prior to the receipt of funds, school districts shall submit
- 21 to the department of education a school infrastructure
- 22 progress report. The report shall provide adequate assurance
- 23 that the school district has developed or is developing a
- 24 school infrastructure plan containing an analysis of school
- 25 district infrastructure needs, priorities, and an estimated
- 26 timetable for completion of infrastructure projects or
- 27 allocation of funds previously received by the school district
- 28 pursuant to subsection 2.
- 4. Moneys received under this section shall not be
- 30 commingled with state aid payments made under section 257.16
- 31 to a school district, and shall be accounted for by the school
- 32 district separately from state aid payments. Payments made to
- 33 school districts pursuant to this section are miscellaneous
- 34 income for purposes of chapter 257 or are considered
- 35 encumbered. Each school district shall maintain a separate

- 1 listing within its budget for payments received and
- 2 expenditures made pursuant to this section. Moneys received
- 3 under this section shall not be used for payment of any
- 4 collective bargaining agreement or arbitrator's decision
- 5 negotiated or awarded under chapter 20.
- 6 5. For purposes of this chapter, a "school district" shall
- 7 mean a school district as defined in section 257.2.
- 8 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 297A.2 SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE
- 9 EXPENDITURES.
- 10 1. School districts shall expend funds received pursuant
- 11 to section 297A.1 for school infrastructure needs. For
- 12 purposes of this chapter, "school infrastructure" includes the
- 13 following:
- 14 a. Activities for which a school district is authorized to
- 15 contract indebtedness and issue general obligation bonds under
- 16 section 296.1, except those activities related to a teacher's
- 17 or superintendent's home or homes. These activities include
- 18 the construction, reconstruction, repair, purchasing, or
- 19 remodeling of schoolhouses, stadiums, gyms, fieldhouses, and
- 20 bus garages.
- 21 b. Procurement of school house construction sites and the
- 22 making of site improvements.
- 23 c. Payment or retirement of outstanding bonds previously
- 24 issued for school infrastructure purposes, as defined in this
- 25 subsection, if it is determined by the department of education
- 26 that the school district has undertaken a serious effort to
- 27 meet its school infrastructure needs. In making this
- 28 determination, the department shall consider the relative size
- 29 and property tax base of the school district, and the
- 30 information provided to the department in the school
- 31 district's infrastructure progress report pursuant to section
- 32 297A.1.
- 33 d. Maintenance of schoolhouses and school district
- 34 property.
- 35 e. School improvement technology programs pursuant to

1 chapter 295, utilized for a school district.

2 2. Funds received by a school district pursuant to this 3 chapter shall not be expended to add a full-time equivalent 4 position or otherwise increase staffing.

5 EXPLANATION

This bill provides for the creation of a school
infrastructure fund established, maintained, and administered
by the department of education, and appropriates annually from
the general fund of the state to the department the sum of
million to be allocated to a school districts for school
infrastructure purposes. The amount of moneys allocated to
school district shall be in the proportion that the basic
enrollment of the district bears to the sum of the basic
enrollments of all school districts in the state for the
budget year. The allocation shall be made to school districts
by the department of management in one payment on or about
October 15 annually, based upon the actual enrollment
certified to the department of education for each school
district, taking into consideration the relative budget and

20 cash position of the state resources.
21 Prior to the receipt of funds, by October 1 annually,
22 school districts shall submit to the department of education a
23 school infrastructure progress report providing adequate
24 assurance that the school district has developed or is

25 developing a school infrastructure plan containing an analysis

26 of school district infrastructure needs, priorities, and an

27 estimated timetable for completion of infrastructure projects

28 or allocation of funds received by the school district.

The bill provides that school districts shall expend the appropriated funds for school infrastructure needs, which are

31 defined to include the construction, reconstruction, repair,

32 purchasing, or remodeling of schoolhouses, stadiums, gyms,

33 fieldhouses, and bus garages; the procurement of school house

34 construction sites and the making of site improvements; and

35 the payment or retirement of outstanding bonds previously

l issued for school infrastructure purposes if the department of 2 education determines that the school district has made a 3 significant effort in meeting its infrastructure needs. 4 Additionally, school infrastructure includes the maintenance 5 of schoolhouses and school district property, and school 6 improvement technology programs pursuant to chapter 295.
