1 An Act relating to the reissuance of special instruction permits
2 to operate motor vehicles to persons with physical
3 disabilities.

1 Section 1. Section 321.180A, subsection 3, Code 1997, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 3. The permittee may apply for a motor vehicle license if
4 thirty days have elapsed since issuance of the special
5 instruction permit. The department shall issue a motor
6 vehicle license if the permittee is qualified, passes all
7 required tests, including a driving test, and pays the
8 required fees. If the person has not obtained a motor vehicle
9 license before expiration of the person's special instruction
10 permit, the person's former denial or suspension under section
11 321.177, subsection 6 or 7, or section 321.210, subsection 1,
12 paragraph "c", upon service of notice by the department, shall
13 be reinstated. A permit shall be reissued for one or more
14 additional six-month period periods if a permittee continues
15 to meet the qualifications of subsection 1 and has incurred no
16 motor vehicle violations.

17 EXPLANATION

18 Current law provides for the issuance of a six-month
19 special instruction permit to a person with a physical
20 disability. The permit may be reissued for one additional
21 six-month period. This bill authorizes the reissuance of such
22 a permit for multiple six-month periods.
