1 Section 1. Section 295.2, subsection 1, Code Supplement
2 1997, is amended by adding the following new paragraphs:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. d. There is appropriated from the general
4 fund of the state to the department of education for each year
5 of the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June
6 30, 2006, the sum of forty million dollars for the school
7 improvement technology program.

8 Sec. 2. Section 295.5, Code 1997, is amended to read as
9 follows:

10 295.5 FUTURE REPEAL.

11 This chapter is repealed effective July 1, 2001 2006.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill appropriates moneys from the general fund of the
14 state to the school technology improvement program for an
15 additional five years beyond the current final date of June
16 30, 2001, and increases the current annual appropriation of
17 \$30 million to \$40 million in each of the additional years.
18 The bill also extends to July 1, 2006, the sunset of the
19 chapter creating the school technology improvement program.
