Section 1. Section 15A.1, Code 1997, is amended by adding
 2 the following new subsection:
      NEW SUBSECTION. 4. A state agency shall not provide a

 4 grant, loan, or other financial assistance to a private person-
 5 or on behalf of a private person for economic development when
 6 wage levels are one criteria considered in determining whether
 7 assistance is given, unless a wage level equal to or greater
 8 than one hundred one percent of the average county wage or
 9 twice the amount of the minimum wage is required by the
10 criteria.
