1 Section 1. Section 148E.10, Code 1997, is repealed.

2 EXPLANATION

3 This bill repeals Code section 148E.10, which provides that
4 a registered acupuncturist shall not engage in the performance
5 of acupuncture until the person upon whom the acupuncture is
6 to be performed has been evaluated and referred by a person
7 licensed to practice medicine and surgery, osteopathy,
8 osteopathic medicine and surgery, chiropractic, podiatry, or
9 dentistry. Upon repeal of the Code section, a prior
10 evaluation and referral to an acupuncturist would no longer be
11 necessary in order to obtain acupuncture services.
