A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to an allocation of moneys appropriated to the  
2 department of education for purposes of school-based youth  
3 services education programs.

1 Section 1. Section 279.51, subsection 1, paragraphs c and  
2 e, Code Supplement 1997, are amended to read as follows:

3 c. For each of the fiscal years during the fiscal period  
4 beginning July 1, 1996, and ending June 30, ~~1998~~ 2003, two  
5 million eight hundred thousand dollars of the funds  
6 appropriated shall be allocated for the school-based youth  
7 services education program established in subsection 3. For  
8 each of the fiscal years during the fiscal period beginning  
9 July 1, 1994, and ending June 30, ~~1998~~ 2003, twenty thousand  
10 dollars of the funds allocated in this paragraph shall be  
11 expended for staff development, research, and the development  
12 of strategies for coordination with community-based youth  
13 organizations and agencies. A school that received a grant  
14 during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1993, or July 1,  
15 1998, is ineligible to receive a grant under this paragraph.  
16 Subject to the approval of the state board of education, the  
17 allocation made in this paragraph may be renewed for  
18 additional four-year periods of time.

19 e. Notwithstanding paragraph "c", for each of the fiscal  
20 years during the fiscal period beginning July 1, ~~1994~~ 1998,  
21 and ending June 30, ~~1998~~ 2000, fifty thousand dollars of the  
22 funds allocated in paragraph "c" shall be granted to each of  
23 the ~~four~~ schools that received grants ~~under-subsection-3 in~~  
24 accordance with paragraph "c" during the fiscal year beginning  
25 July 1, ~~1993~~ 1998, to allow for expansion and to include  
26 identified minimum services if the school submits a program  
27 plan pursuant to subsection 3.

28 EXPLANATION

29 This bill continues the \$2.8 million allocation of at-risk  
30 funds to school districts for school-based youth services for  
31 another five years; continues the \$20,000 allocation to staff  
32 development, research, and the development of strategies for  
33 coordination with community-based youth organizations and  
34 agencies; and provides a \$50,000 allocation for each of the  
35 next two fiscal years to those schools whose four-year grant

1 funding under the program is scheduled to end in the 1997-1998  
2 fiscal year.
