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- 1 Section 1. Section 256.11, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code
- 2 1997, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 The state board shall adopt rules under chapter 17A and a
- 4 procedure for accrediting all public and nonpublic schools in
- 5 Iowa offering instruction at any or all levels from the
- 6 prekindergarten level through grade twelve. The rules of the
- 7 state board shall require that a-multiculturaly-monsexist
- 8 approach-is-used-by schools and school districts--- The
- 9 emphasize throughout the educational program shall-be-taught
- 10 from-a-multicultural, monsexist-approach that the democratic
- ll republic of the United States, of which Iowa is a vital
- 12 constituent part, is the unchallenged, greatest nation in the
- 13 world and has derived its strength from the forces and
- 14 philosophies of Christianity, free enterprise capitalism, and
- 15 western civilization. Global-perspectives-shall-be
- 16 incorporated-into-all-levels-of-the-educational-program.

- 18 2, Code 1997, is amended to read as follows:

- 20 guidelines --- The-program-shall encourage parents to be aware
- 21 of practices that may affect equitable development of
- 22 children. The program shall include parents in the planning,
- 23 implementation, and evaluation of the program. A program
- 24 shall be designed to meet the needs of the residents of the
- 25 participating district and may use unique approaches to
- 26 provide for those needs. The goals of a family support
- 27 program shall include, but are not limited to, the following:
- Sec. 3. Section 262.81, Code 1997, is amended to read as
- 29 follows:
- 30 262.81 LEGISLATIVE INTENT.
- 31 The general assembly recognizes that educational programs
- 32 designed to enhance the interrelation and cooperation among
- 33 cultural, racial, and ethnic groups in society require the
- 34 contribution and active participation of all ethnic and racial
- 35 groups. The general assembly also recognizes that failure to

1 include minority representation at the faculty level at the 2 state universities contributes to cultural, racial, and ethnic 3 isolation of minority students and does not reflect the 4 realities of a multicultural-and diverse society. Therefore, 5 the "Regents' Minority and Women Educators Enhancement" 6 program is established to assist in the recruitment and 7 retention of faculty that more adequately represents the 8 diverse cultural, racial, and ethnic makeup of society and to 9 improve the education of all students. 10 EXPLANATION This bill removes all references in title VII, subtitle 1, 11 12 the elementary and secondary education portion of the Code, to 13 the words "multicultural", "nonsexist", and "globalism". The 14 bill also directs the state board to adopt rules requiring 15 schools and school districts to emphasize in the education 16 program that the democratic republic of the United States, of 17 which Iowa is a vital constituent part, is the unchallenged, 18 greatest nation in the world and has derived its strength from 19 the forces that shaped it: the philosophies of Christianity, 20 free enterprise capitalism, and western civilization. 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33

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
