1 Section 1. Section 904A.1, Code 1997, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 904A.1 BOARD OF PAROLE.

4 The board of parole is created to consist of five members.
5 Each member, except the chairperson and the vice chairperson,
6 shall be compensated on a day-to-day basis. Each member shall
7 serve a term of four years beginning and ending as provided by
8 section 69.19, except for members appointed to fill vacancies
9 who shall serve for the balance of the unexpired term. The
10 terms shall be staggered. The chairperson and vice
11 chairperson of the board shall be a full-time, salaried member
12 members of the board. A majority of the members of the board
13 constitutes a quorum to transact business.

14 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 904A.4C VICE CHAIRPERSON OF THE
15 BOARD OF PAROLE.

16 The vice chairperson of the board of parole shall be
17 appointed from the membership of the board of parole by a vote
18 of a majority of the members of the board. The vice
19 chairperson shall serve at the pleasure of the board and shall
20 have such responsibilities and duties as are determined by the
21 board. The vice chairperson shall act as the chairperson in
22 the absence or disability of the chairperson or in the event
23 of a vacancy in that office, until such time as a new
24 chairperson is appointed by the governor.

25 Sec. 3. Section 904A.6, Code 1997, is amended to read as
26 follows:

27 904A.6 SALARIES AND EXPENSES.

28 Each member, except the chairperson and the vice
29 chairperson, of the board shall be paid per diem as determined
30 by the general assembly. The chairperson and vice chairperson
31 of the board shall be paid a salary as determined by the
32 general assembly. Each member of the board and all employees
33 are entitled to receive, in addition to their per diem or
34 salary, their necessary maintenance and travel expenses while
35 engaged in official business.

1 Section 1. Section 904A.1, Code 1997, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 904A.1 BOARD OF PAROLE.

4 The board of parole is created to consist of five members.
5 Each member, except the chairperson and the vice chairperson,
6 shall be compensated on a day-to-day basis. Each member shall
7 serve a term of four years beginning and ending as provided by
8 section 69.19, except for members appointed to fill vacancies
9 who shall serve for the balance of the unexpired term. The
10 terms shall be staggered. The chairperson and vice
11 chairperson of the board shall be a full-time, salaried member
12 members of the board. A majority of the members of the board
13 constitutes a quorum to transact business.

14 Sec. 2. Section 904A.4A, Code 1997, is amended by adding
15 the following new subsection:

16 NEW SUBSECTION. 7. Appoint a member of the board of
17 parole to serve as vice chairperson and determine the duties
18 of the vice chairperson.

19 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 904A.4C VICE CHAIRPERSON OF THE
20 BOARD OF PAROLE.

21 The vice chairperson of the board of parole shall be
22 appointed from the membership of the board of parole by the
23 chairperson. The vice chairperson shall serve at the pleasure
24 of the chairperson and shall have such responsibilities and
25 duties as are determined by the chairperson. The vice
26 chairperson shall act as the chairperson in the absence or
27 disability of the chairperson or in the event of a vacancy in
28 that office, until such time as a new chairperson is appointed
29 by the governor.

30 Sec. 4. Section 904A.6, Code 1997, is amended to read as
31 follows:

32 904A.6 SALARIES AND EXPENSES.

33 Each member, except the chairperson and the vice
34 chairperson, of the board shall be paid per diem as determined
35 by the general assembly. The chairperson and vice chairperson

1 of the board shall be paid a salary as determined by the
2 general assembly. Each member of the board and all employees
3 are entitled to receive, in addition to their per diem or
4 salary, their necessary maintenance and travel expenses while
5 engaged in official business.

6 Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect May 1,
7 1998.

8 EXPLANATION

9 This bill provides for the appointment of a vice
10 chairperson of the board of parole. The vice chairperson is
11 to be appointed by the chairperson of the board of parole and
12 serves at the pleasure of the chairperson. The chairperson of
13 the board is also to determine the duties to be performed by
14 the vice chairperson of the board. The position of vice
15 chairperson is, like the position of chairperson, a salaried
16 position. The amount of the salary of the vice chairperson,
17 like the salary of the chairperson, is to be determined by the
18 general assembly. The vice chairperson is to assume the
19 duties of the chairperson in the absence or disability of the
20 chairperson or in the event of a vacancy in the office of
21 chairperson, until the governor appoints a replacement
22 chairperson. The bill takes effect May 1, 1998.
