- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 123.56A MANUFACTURE OF BEER FOR
 2 PERSONAL OR FAMILY USE -- EXEMPTION.
- 1. A person who is not prohibited from possessing
- 4 alcoholic beverages and who manufactures beer in the person's
- 5 residence for personal or family use, and not for sale, in the
- 6 amounts provided in this section shall be exempt from the
- 7 requirements of this chapter governing the manufacture and
- 8 sale of beer.
- 9 2. The aggregate amount of beer permitted to be
- 10 manufactured with respect to any person's residence shall be
- ll as follows:
- 12 a. An amount not in excess of two hundred gallons per
- 13 calendar year if there are two or more persons not prohibited
- 14 from possessing alcoholic beverages in the residence.
- 15 b. An amount not in excess of one hundred gallons per
- 16 calendar year if there is only one person not prohibited from
- 17 possessing alcoholic beverages in the residence.
- 18 3. Any personal or family manufacture of beer in excess of
- 19 the amounts permitted in this section or any sale of such beer
- 20 shall not be exempt from the requirements of this chapter
- 21 governing the manufacture and sale of beer.
- 4. Beer manufactured under the provisions of this section
- 23 may be removed from the premises where made for personal or
- 24 family use, including use at organized affairs, exhibitions,
- 25 or competitions. Beer used as provided in this subsection
- 26 shall not be sold or offered for sale.
- 27 EXPLANATION
- 28 This bill provides an exemption from the requirements of
- 29 chapter 123 governing alcoholic beverages concerning beer
- 30 manufactured for personal or family use and not for sale. The
- 31 bill provides for limits on the total amount of beer that can
- 32 be brewed at a person's residence based upon the number of
- 33 persons in the residence permitted to possess alcohol. The
- 34 bill provides that a person is not exempt from the
- 35 requirements of chapter 123 if the person brews beer in an

1 amount that exceeds the limits specified in the bill. The 2 bill also provides that the beer can be removed from the place 3 of manufacture for personal or family use, including use at 4 organized exhibitions or competitions.
